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

Figure 1. Number of Traffic Stops per Year






Figure 2. Ethnic Composition of Traffic Stops by Year




Figure 3. Difference in Likelihood of Being Searched, by Ethnicity and Type of Stop

The figure shows the percentage difference in the likelihood of Hispanics being searched as compared to Whites by purpose of stop.




Figure 4. Ethnic Differences in the Likelihood of Search

The figure shows the percentage difference in the likelihood of Hispanics being searched as compared to Whites.




Figure 5. Ethnic Differences in the Likelihood of Search by Gender

The figure shows the percentage difference in the likelihood of Hispanics being searched as compared to Whites by gender.







Figure 6. Ethnic Differences in the Liklihood of Search by Gender, for Drivers Under 30










Figure 8. Number of Stops, by Ethnicity and Gender




Figure 9. Percent of Stops Resulting in a Search, by Ethnicity and Gender

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

On average, officers stop 5.60 Whites for each Hispanic stopped.




Figure 11. Number of Hispanic and White Motorists Searched, by Officer

On average, officers search 2.77 Whites for each Hispanic searched.




Figure 12. Percent of White and Hispanic Drivers Searched, by Officer




Figure A1. Stops by Day of the Week







Figure A2. Searches by Day of the Week

The figure excludes cases where the hour and minute was exactly 0:00. These cases were presumed to be missing data.





Figure A5. Ethnic Differences in the Likelihood of Search: Consent Searches Only
