Whites Get Larger Sums For Tuition

RICHMOND, VA.—A vast difference between sums allotted for the education of white and colored children was indicated in a report made by Forbes H. Norris, assistant superintendent.

Elementary instruction for colored in Richmond costs \$14.16 and \$73.87 for white. In high schools the cost is \$50.43 for Negroes and \$75.87 for whites.
