

Codebook for Encyclopedia of Associations Data on Environmental Groups

1. Selection procedures: All groups indicating a concern with environmental questions and listed in the Encyclopedia were included. This included those listed under the keywords "environmental quality", "environmental protection," "wildlife conservation," and "conservation," as well as selected groups listed under "water resources," "ecology," "environmental law," "fishing," "forestry," and "ornithology." In addition, each entry in the entire Encyclopedia was read to determine if some other groups should be included, even if they had not been listed under the appropriate keyword. Finally, those groups that were clearly tied to industry, such as chemical company consortia conducting environmental research, were deleted. The resulting dataset therefore contains all groups primarily concerned with environmental issues in each edition of the Encyclopedia studied.

2. Years covered: 1990 edition; 1980; 1970; 1961. The Encyclopedia began its annual editions only in 1961, and grew over the years to be much larger than it was at the beginning. Partly, this is due to the growth in the number of Associations, but partly it is certainly due to a more complete census each year. Groups rarely drop out of the Encyclopedia once included, but they often are not included in their first years of existence. Because the Encyclopedia includes information on the creation dates of the groups, we can judge how much of the growth in the number of groups listed is due to increases in accuracy, and how much is due to the growth in the number of groups in existence. Generally speaking, we find that those groups overlooked for a given period tend to be extremely small.

3. Data

Identification number. Sequential number, 1 to 461.

Membership base:
