



UNITE members have a message for Congress: “Bad Trade Deals Cost Good Jobs.”

Since NAFTA went into effect, over 500,000 garment and textile workers have lost their jobs. Bad trade deals, being pushed by corporate interests in Congress, weaken our ability to bargain for better contracts, and have created sweatshops around the world.

Those who've lost their jobs, take jobs paying 20% less.

How can we Fight Back?

In the last two years, we fought in Congress against Fast Track, NAFTA for Africa and the Caribbean, and we protested against the World Trade Organization model for Trade agreements without labor, human, environmental or consumer protections.

In 2000, UNITE will lead the fight to keep Congress from granting Permanent Normal Trade Relations (PNTR) to China. UNITE opposes PNTR for China until China shows real improvements in its labor, environmental and human rights standards.
