

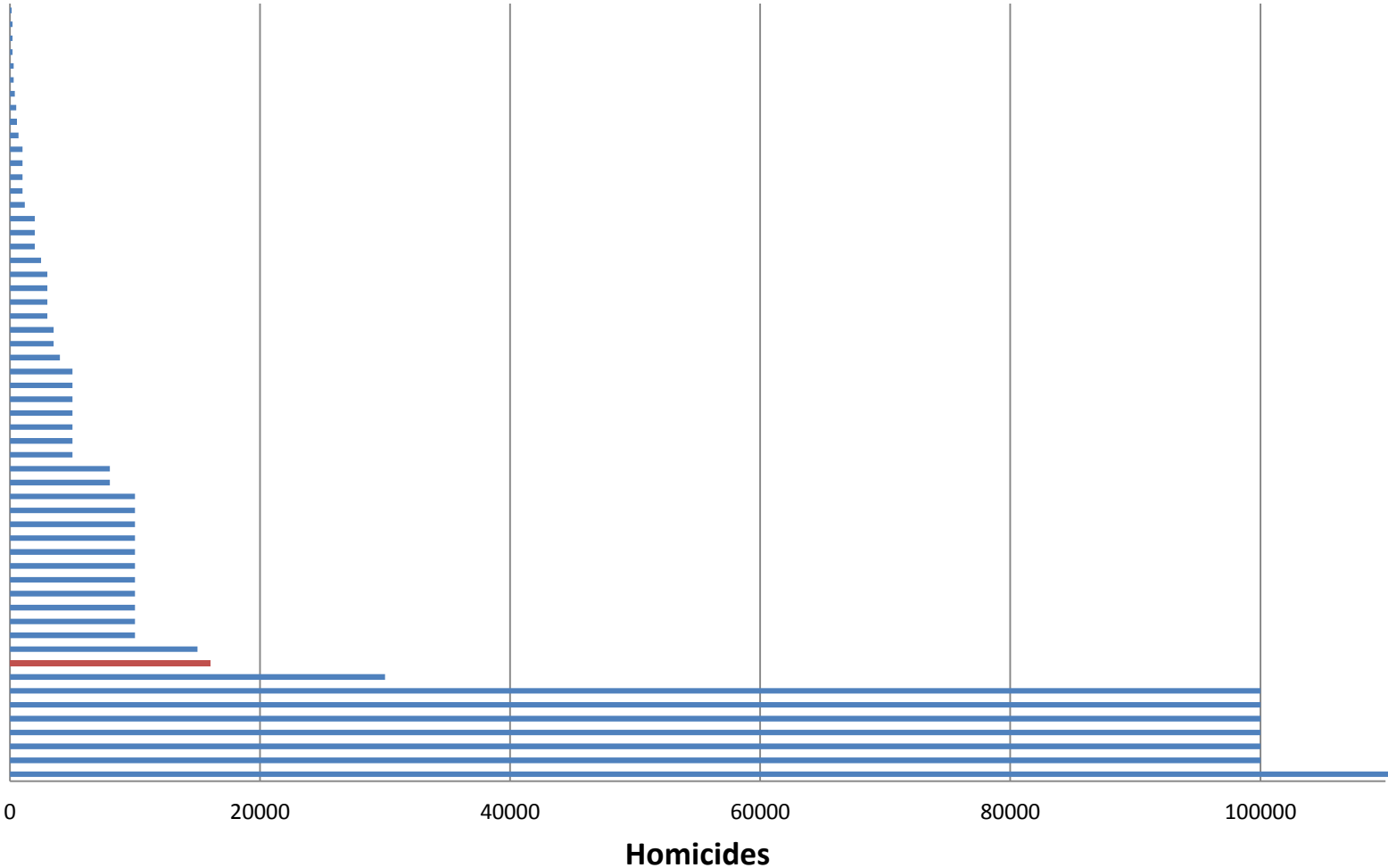

questions led to a majority of correct responses.

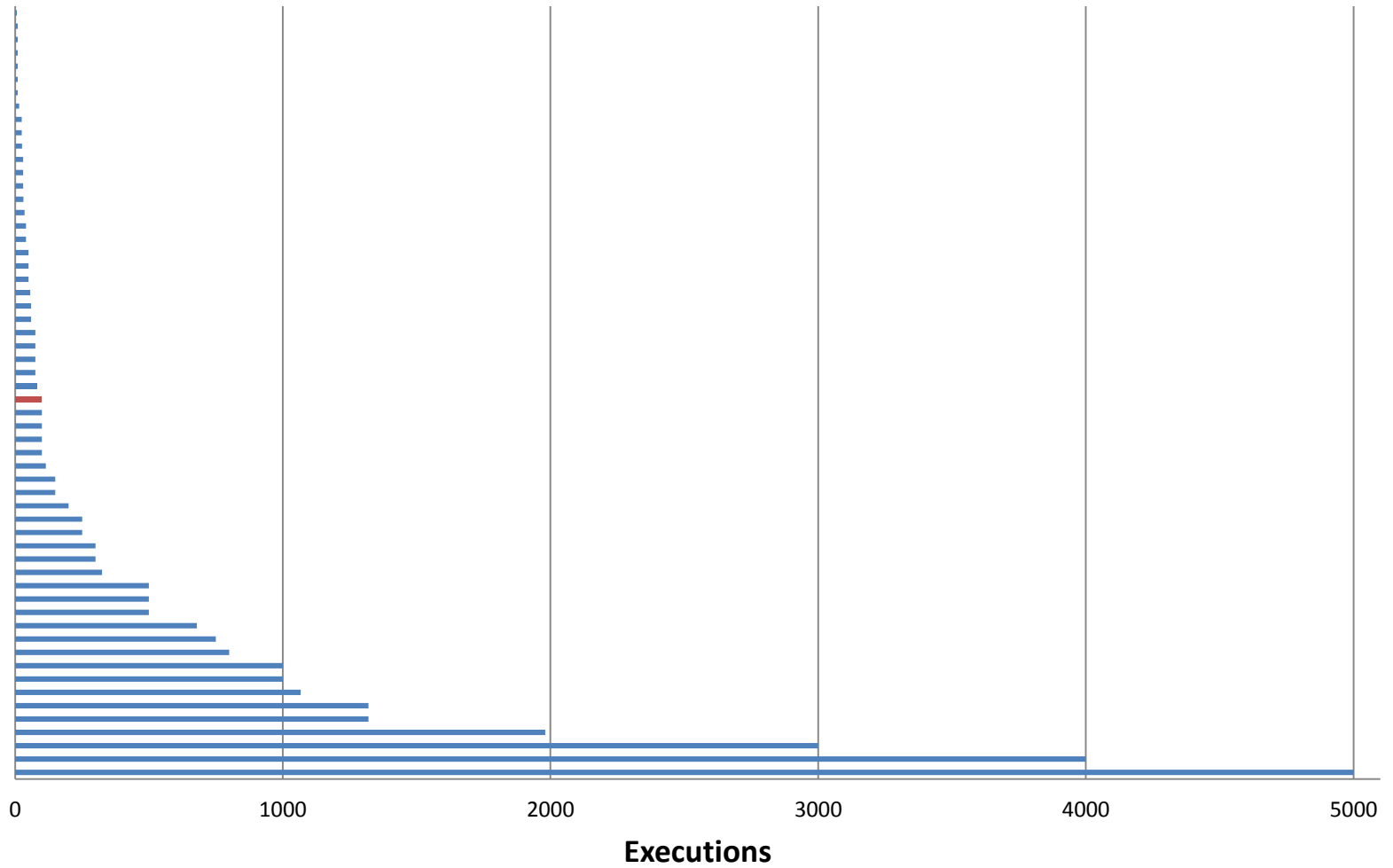

Q1 – About how many homicides in US each year?



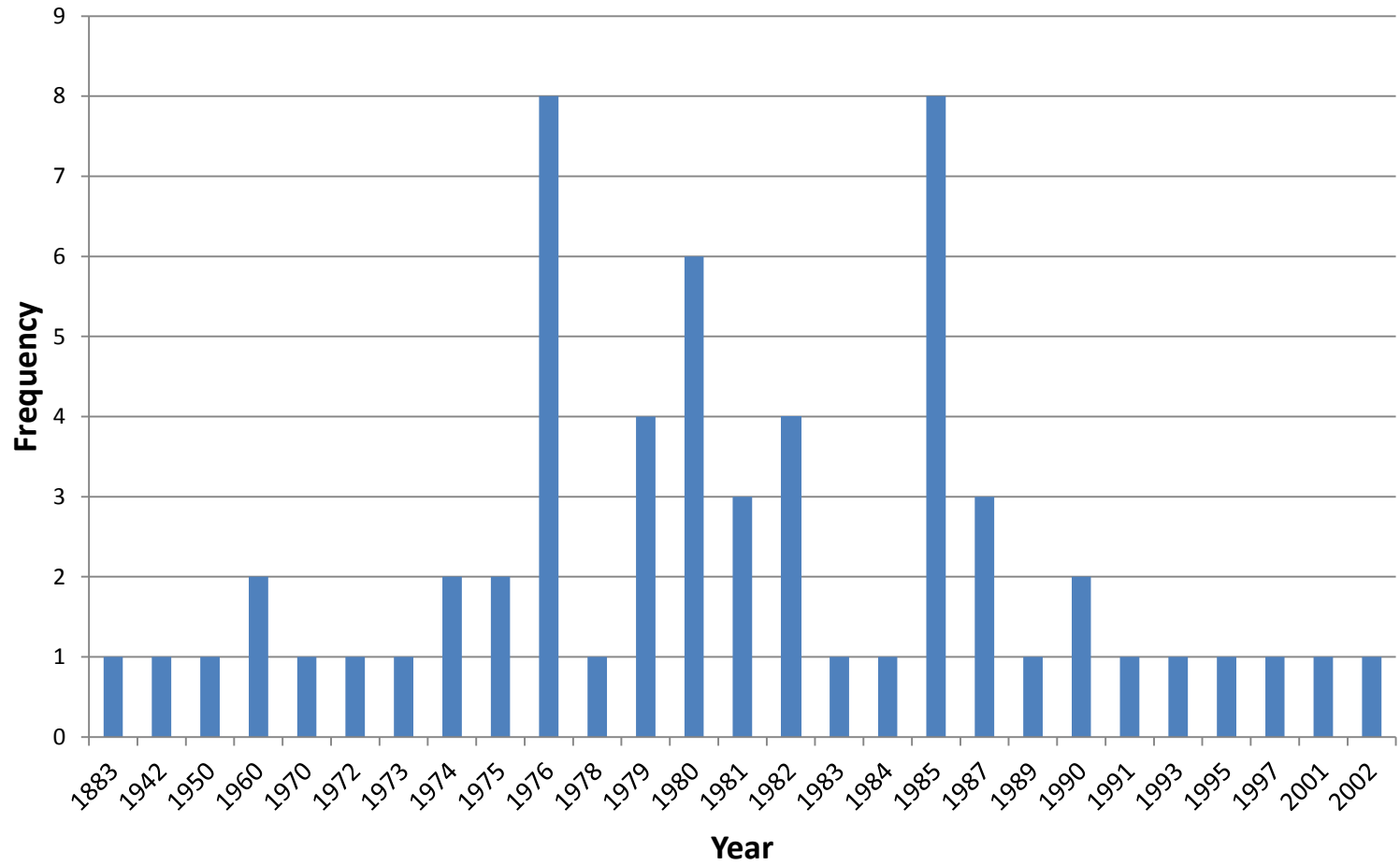

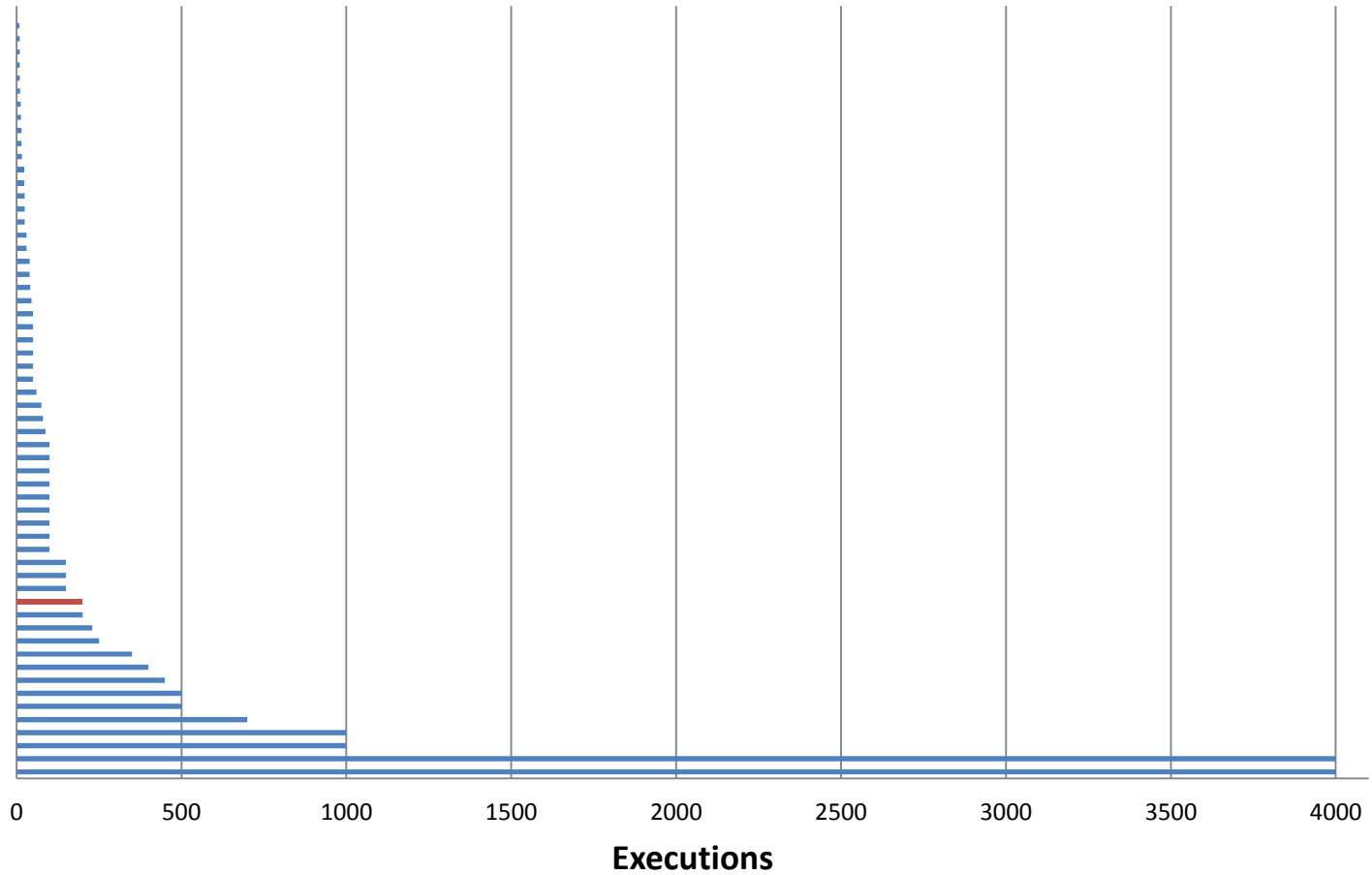

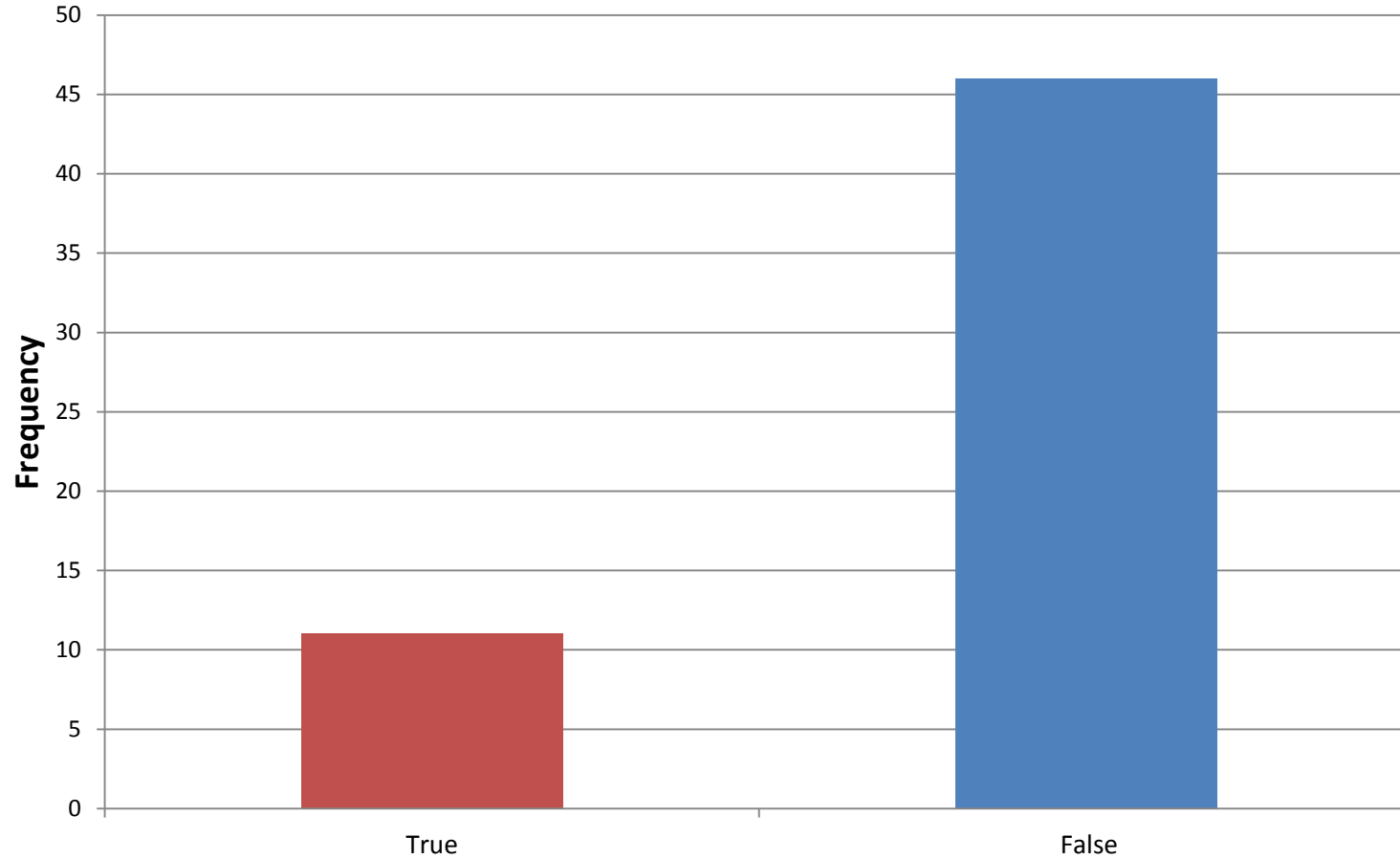

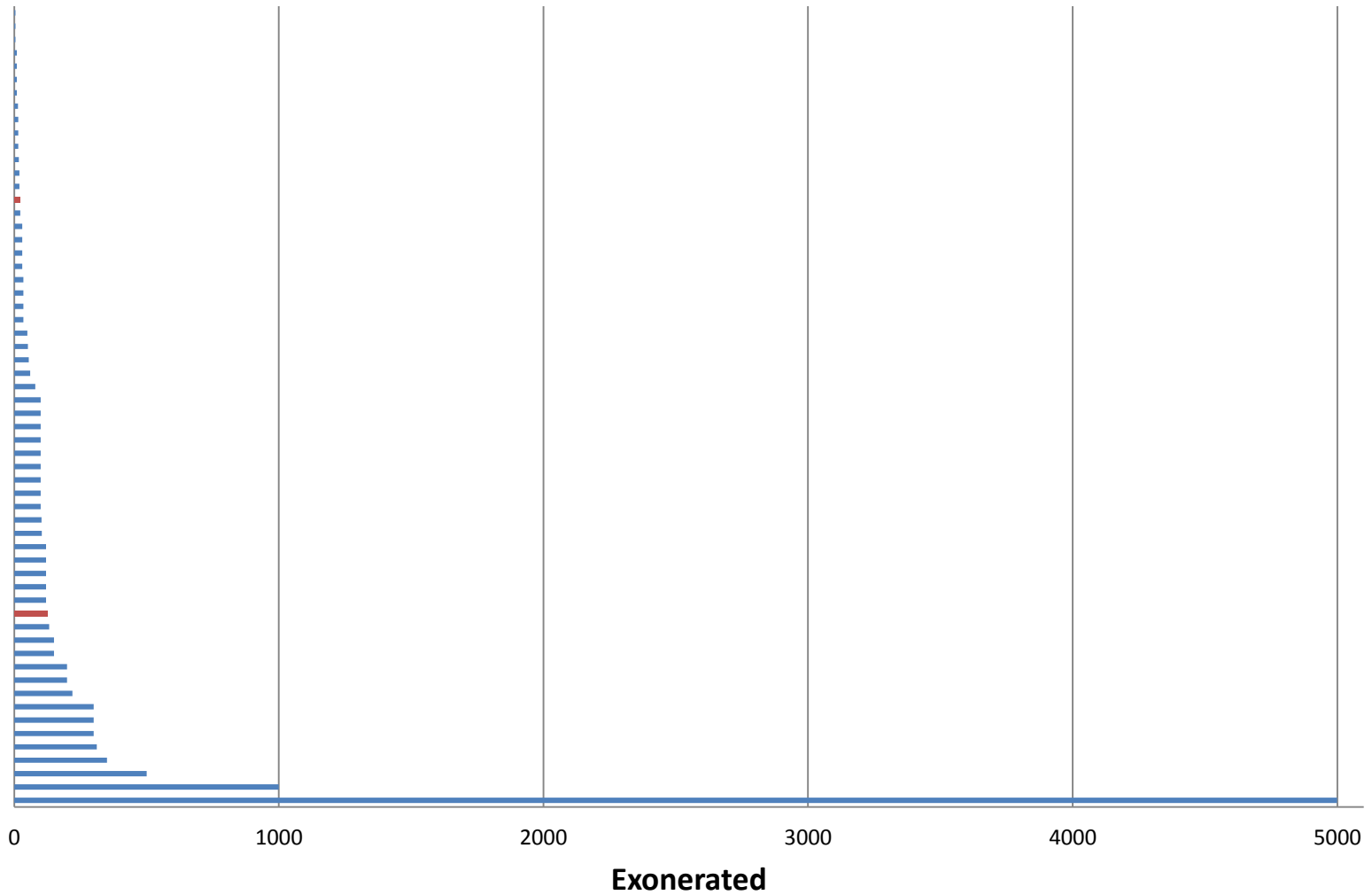

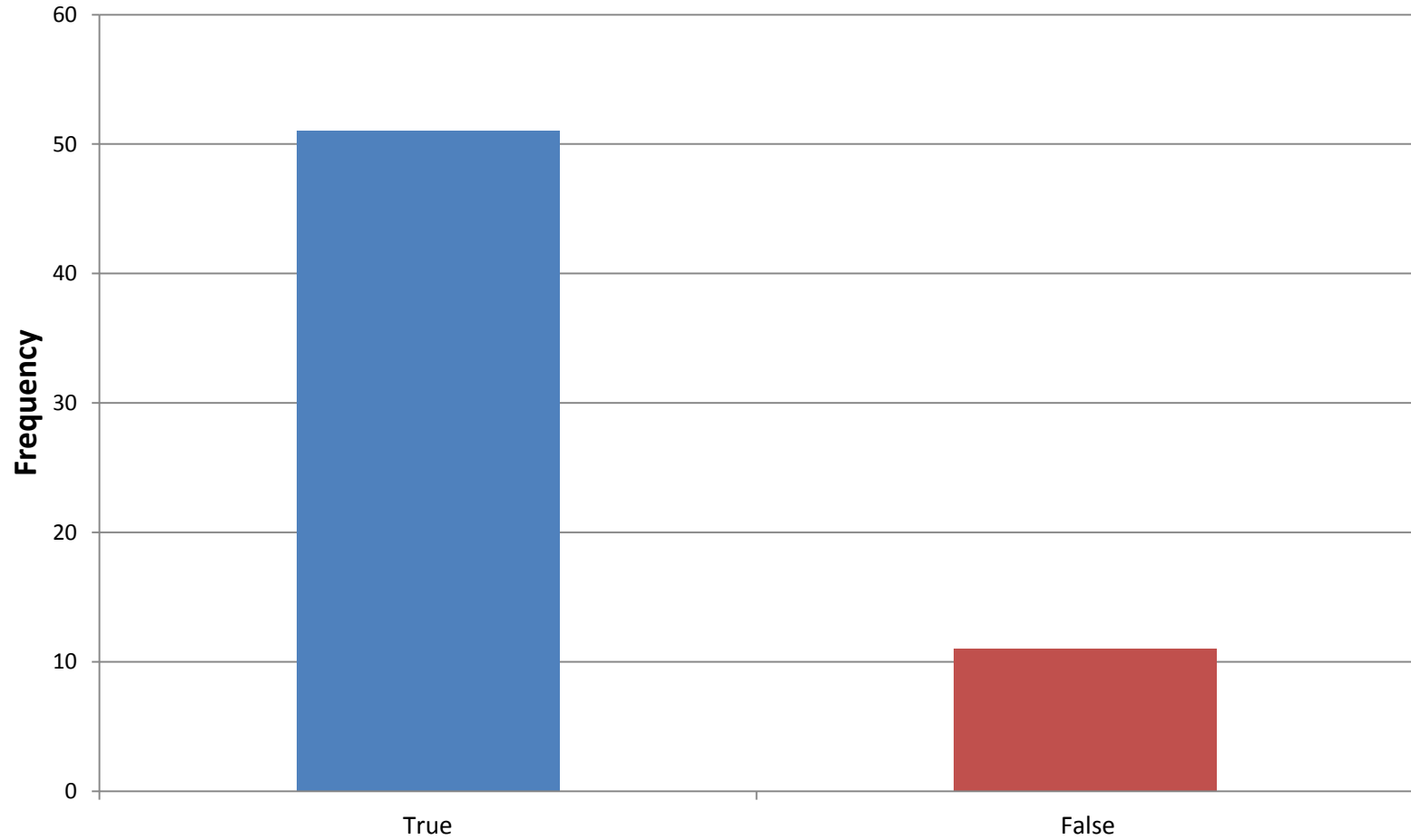

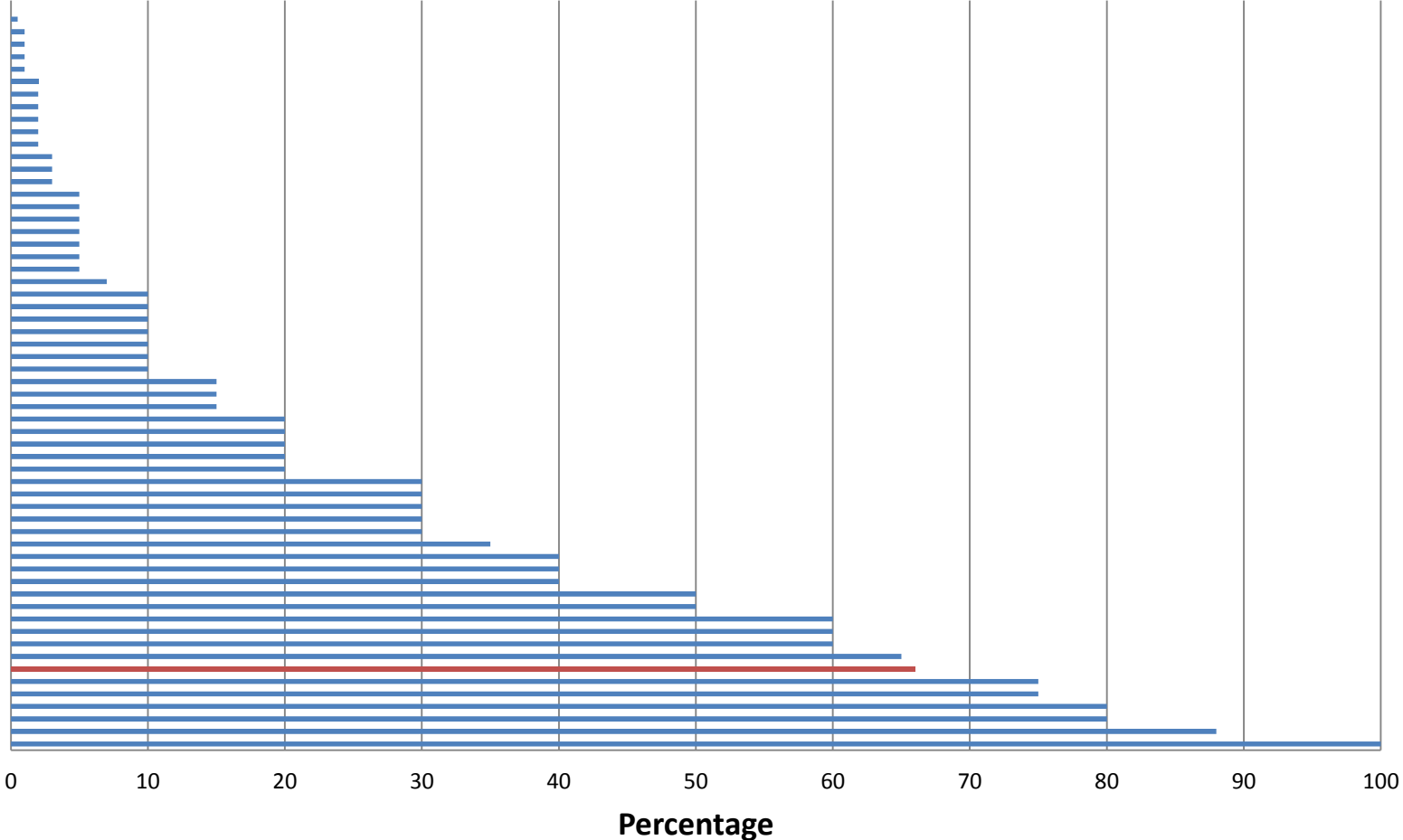

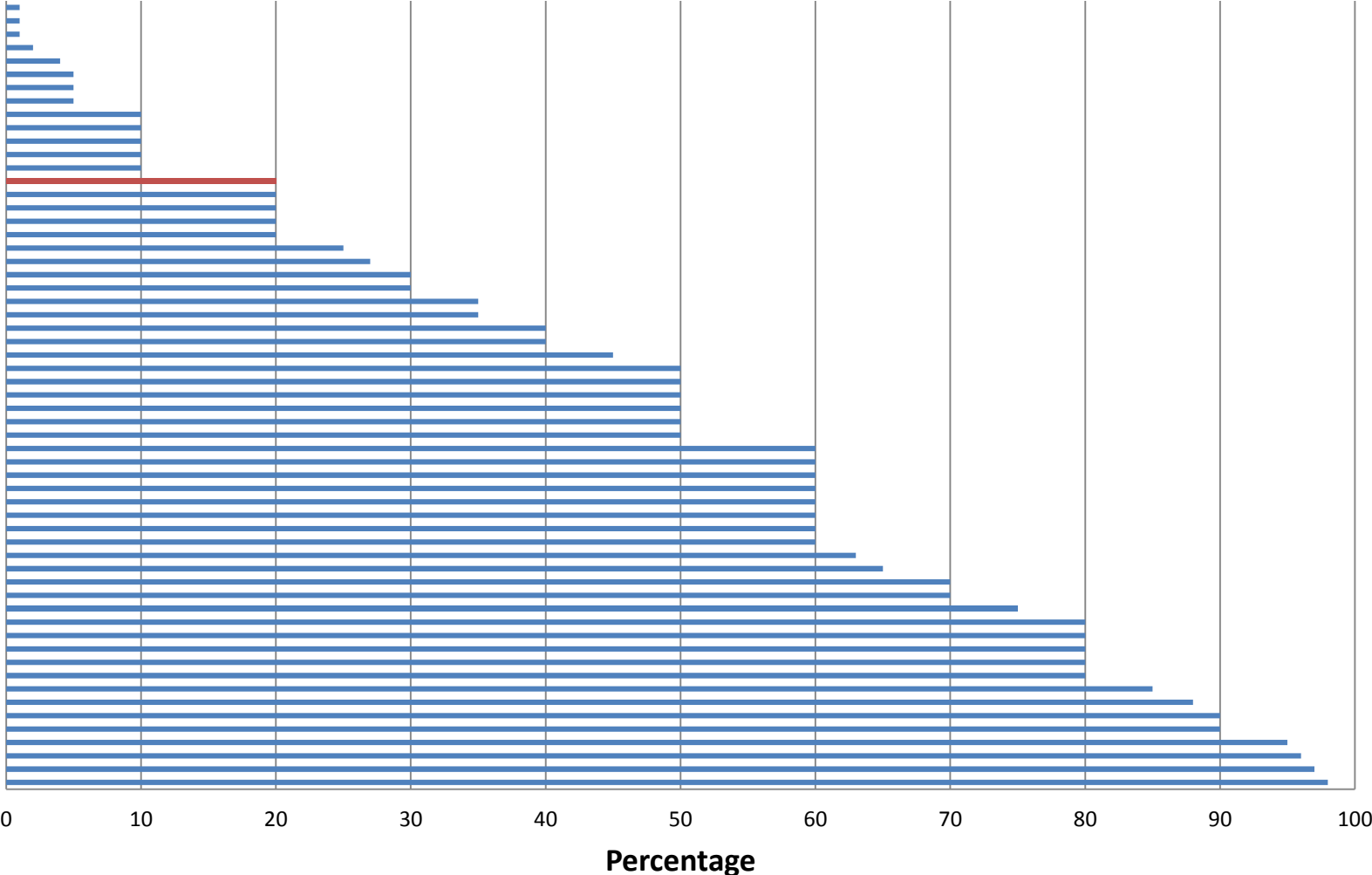

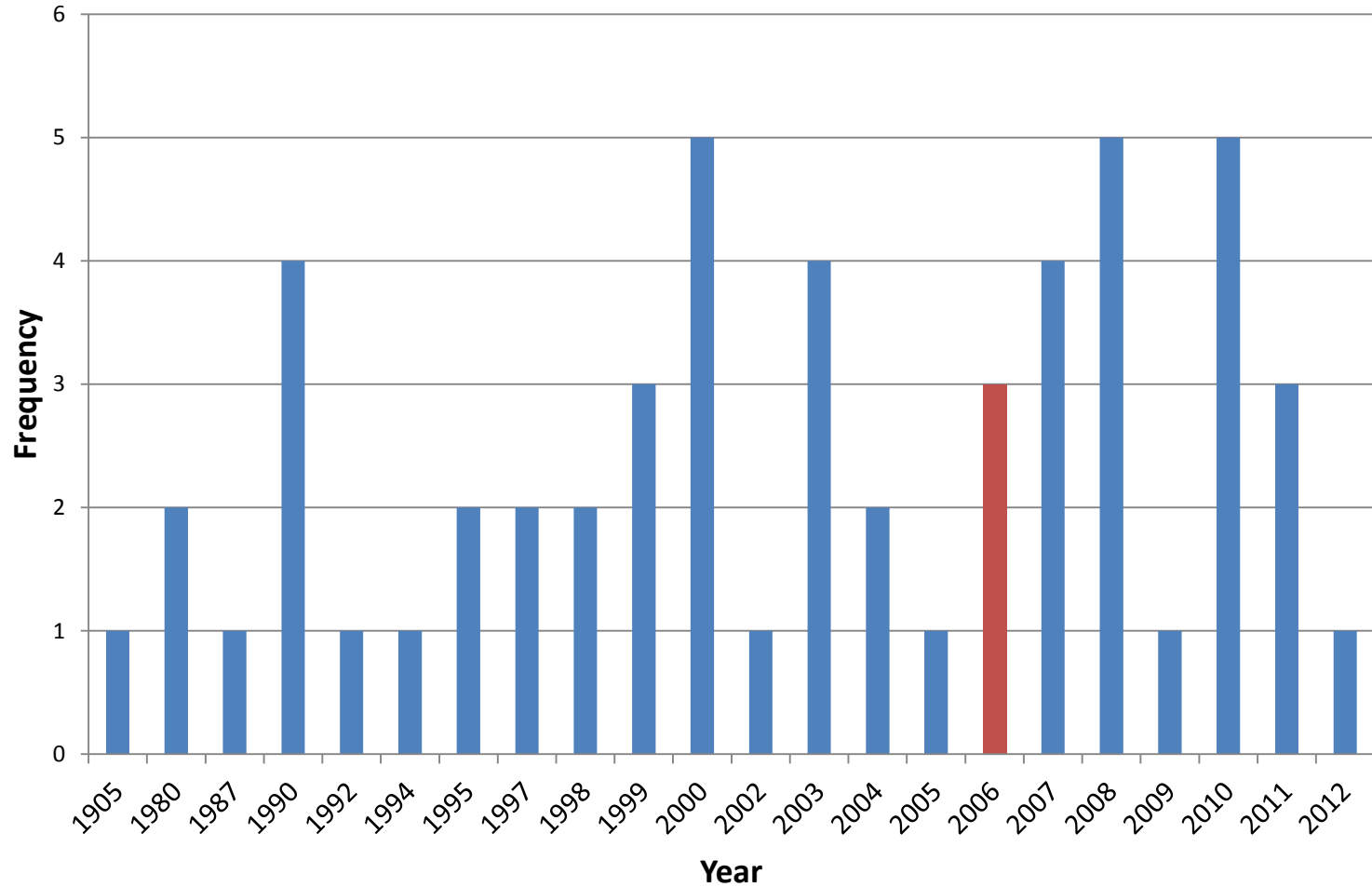

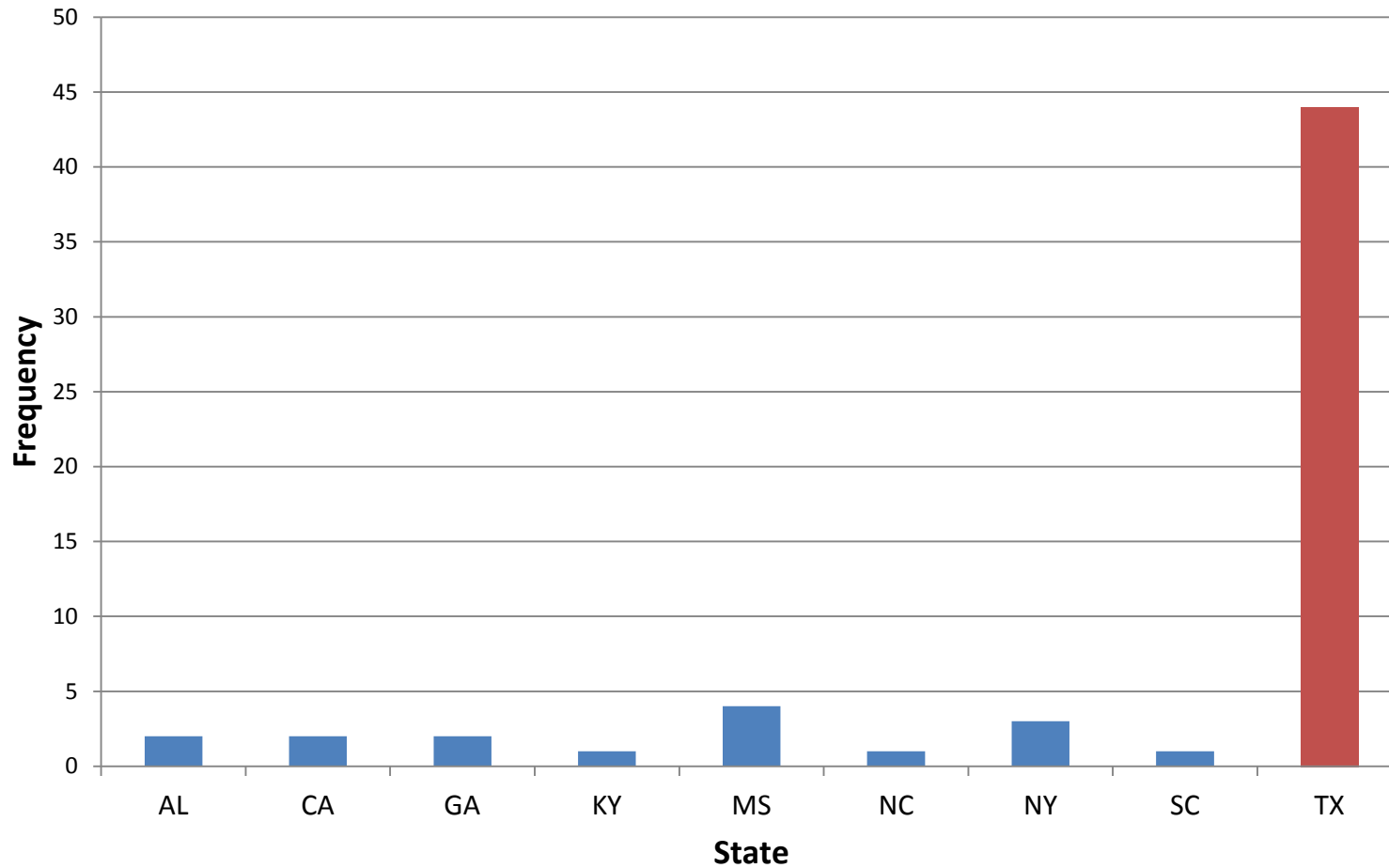

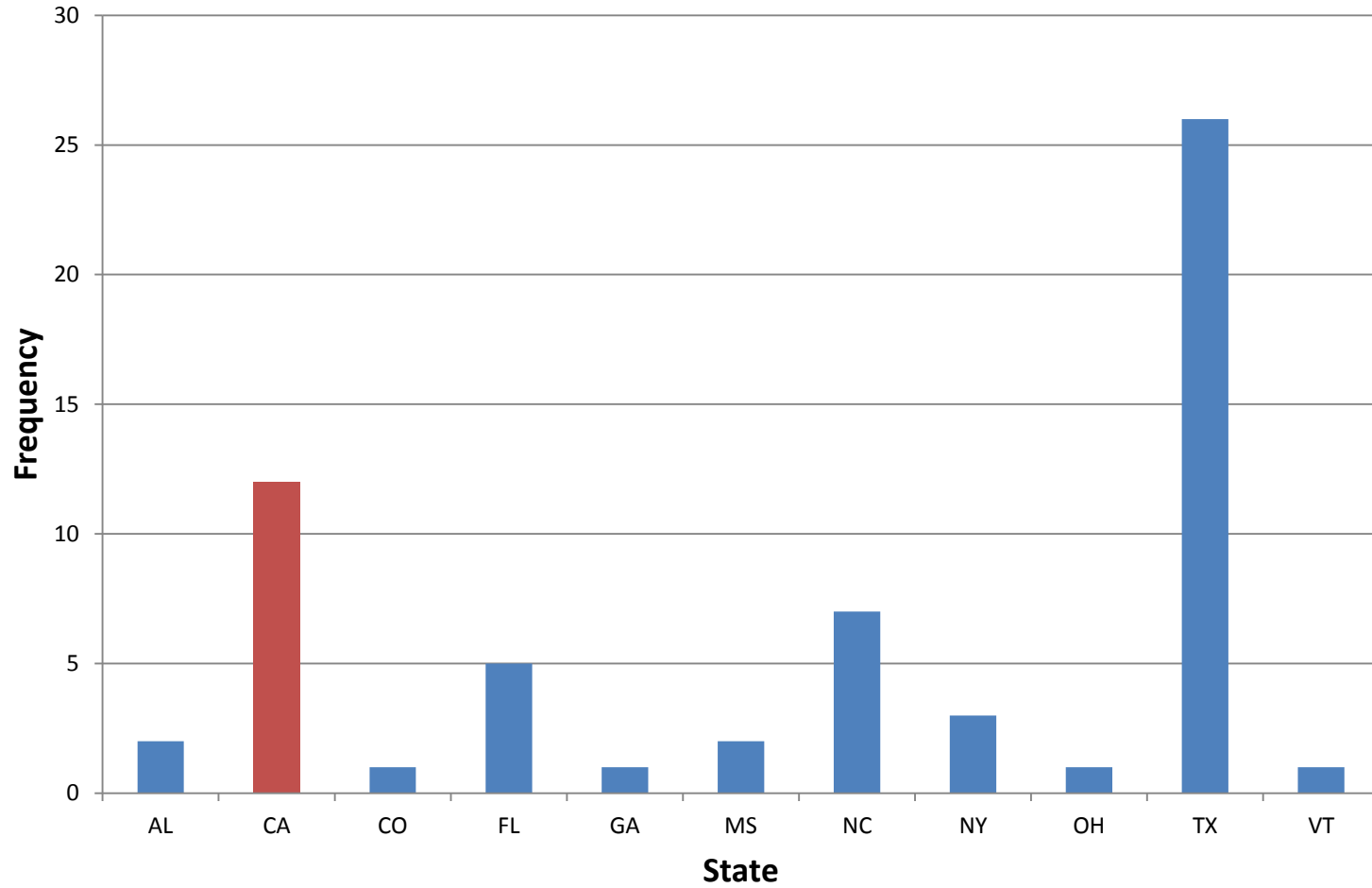

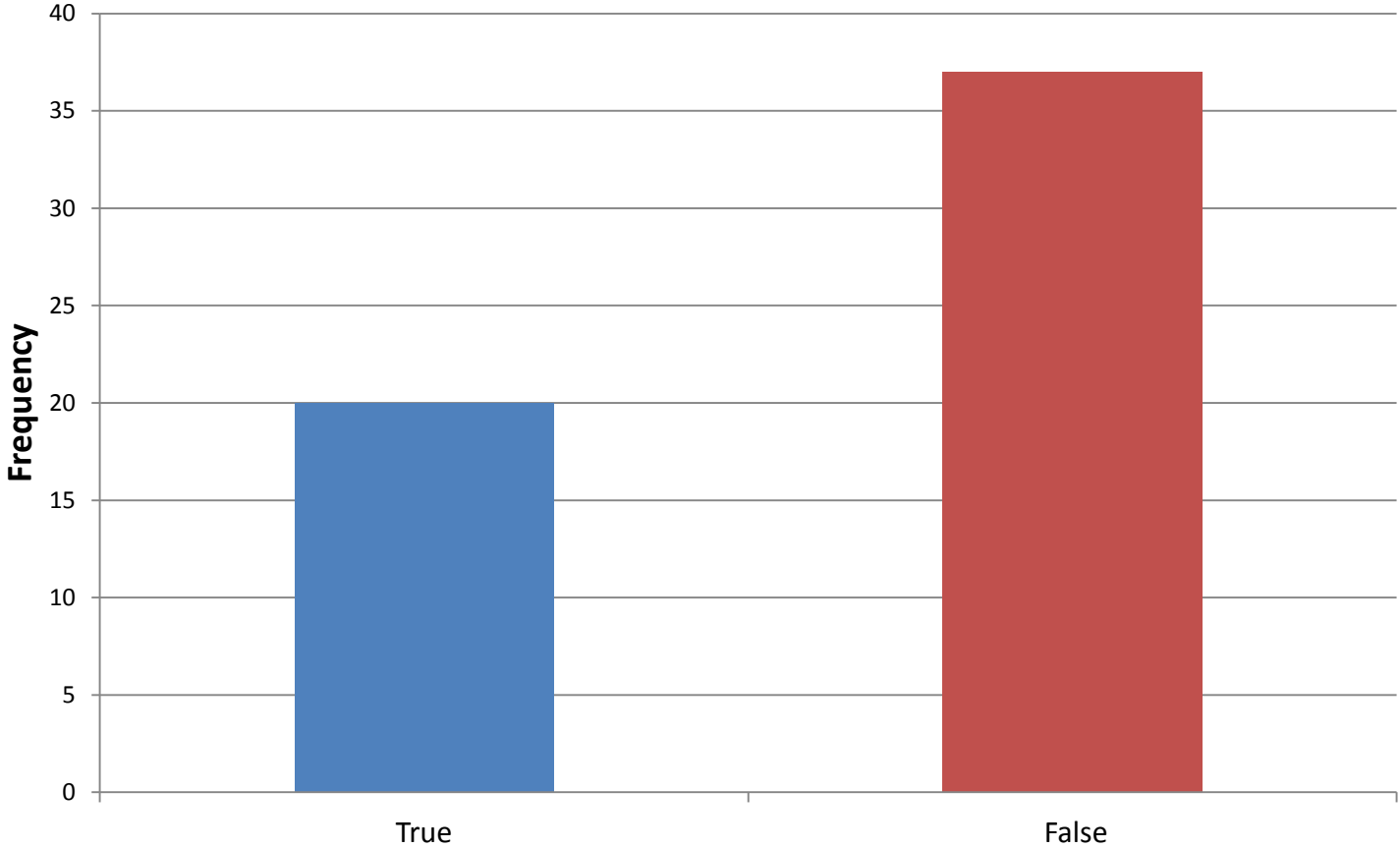

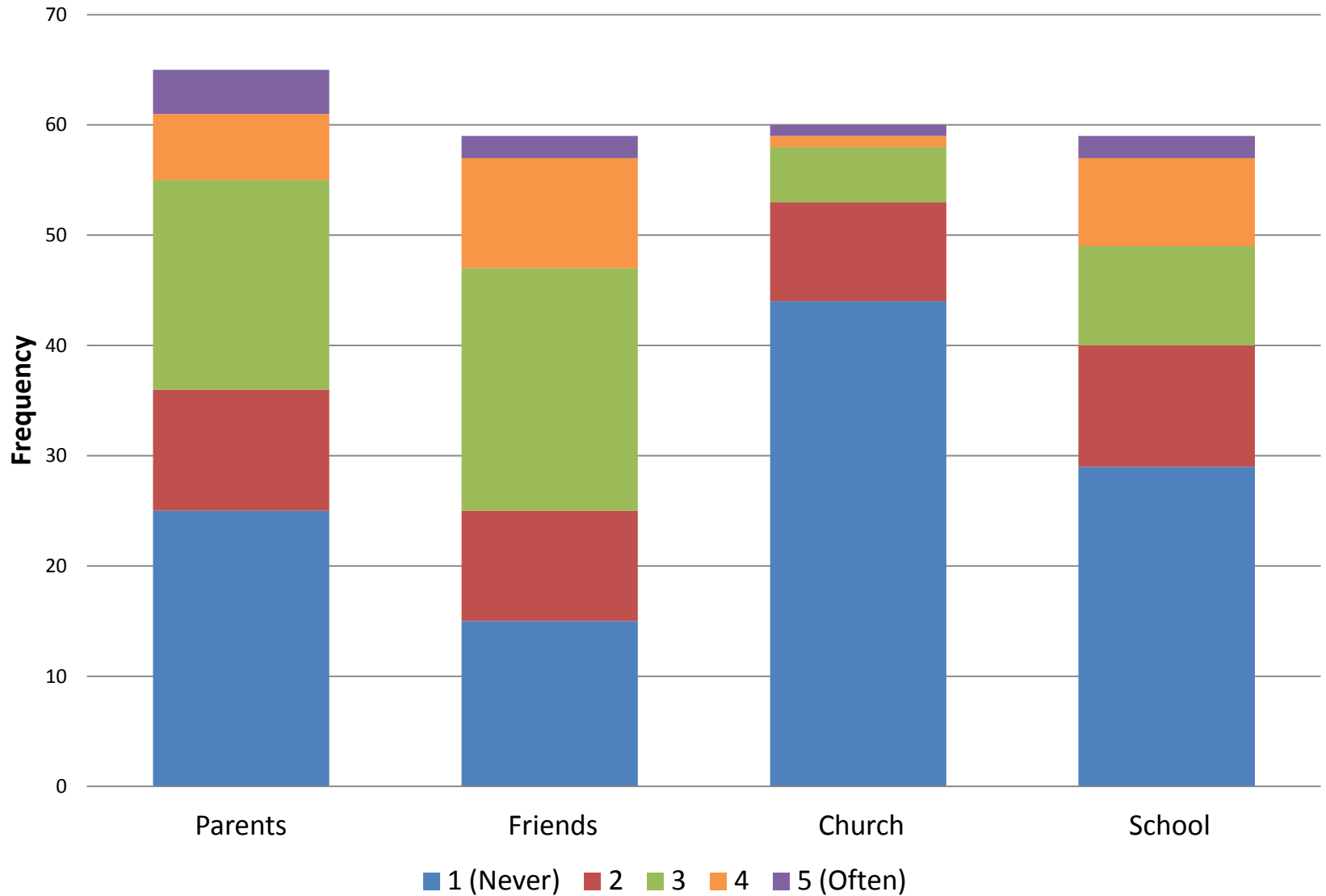
