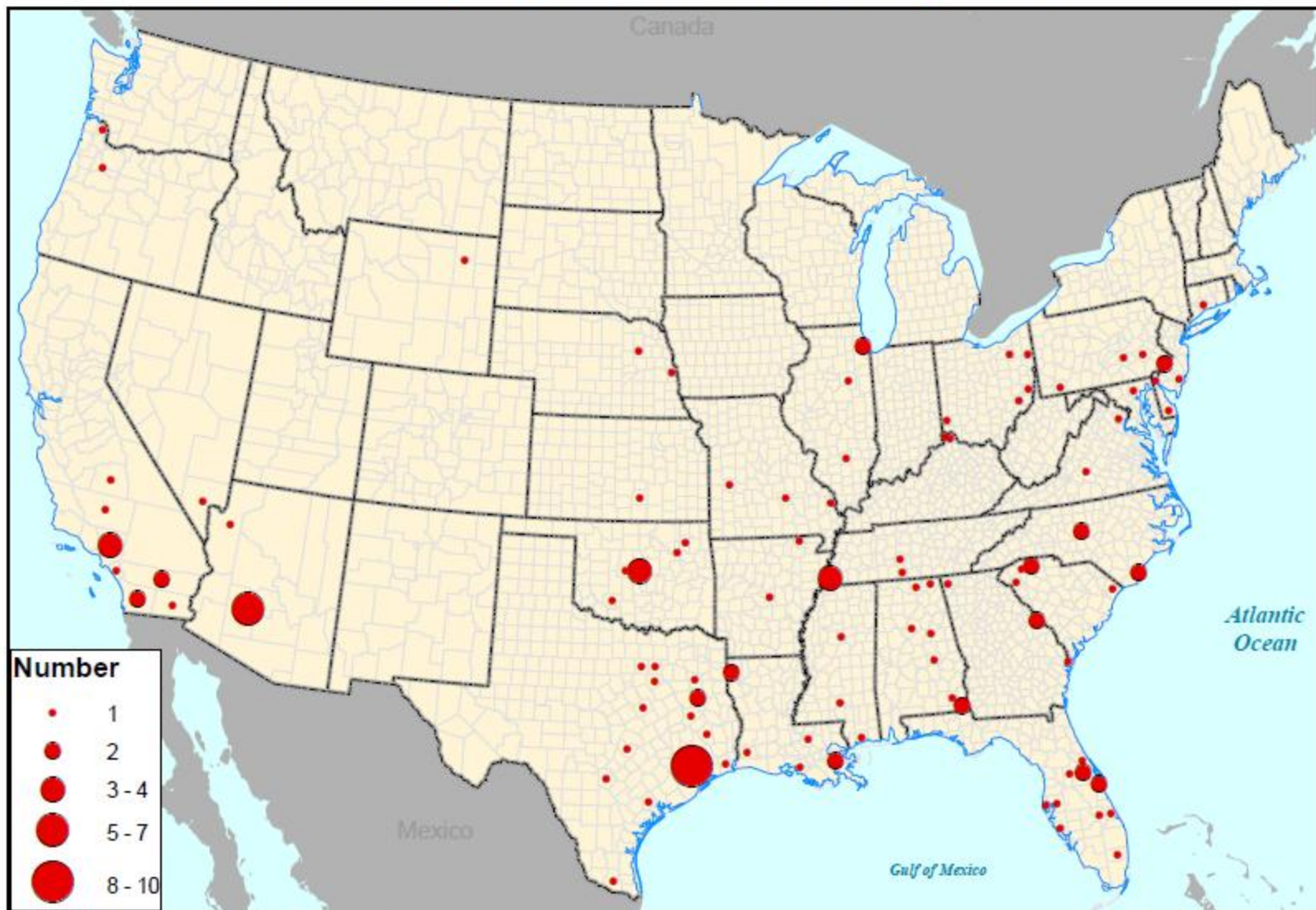

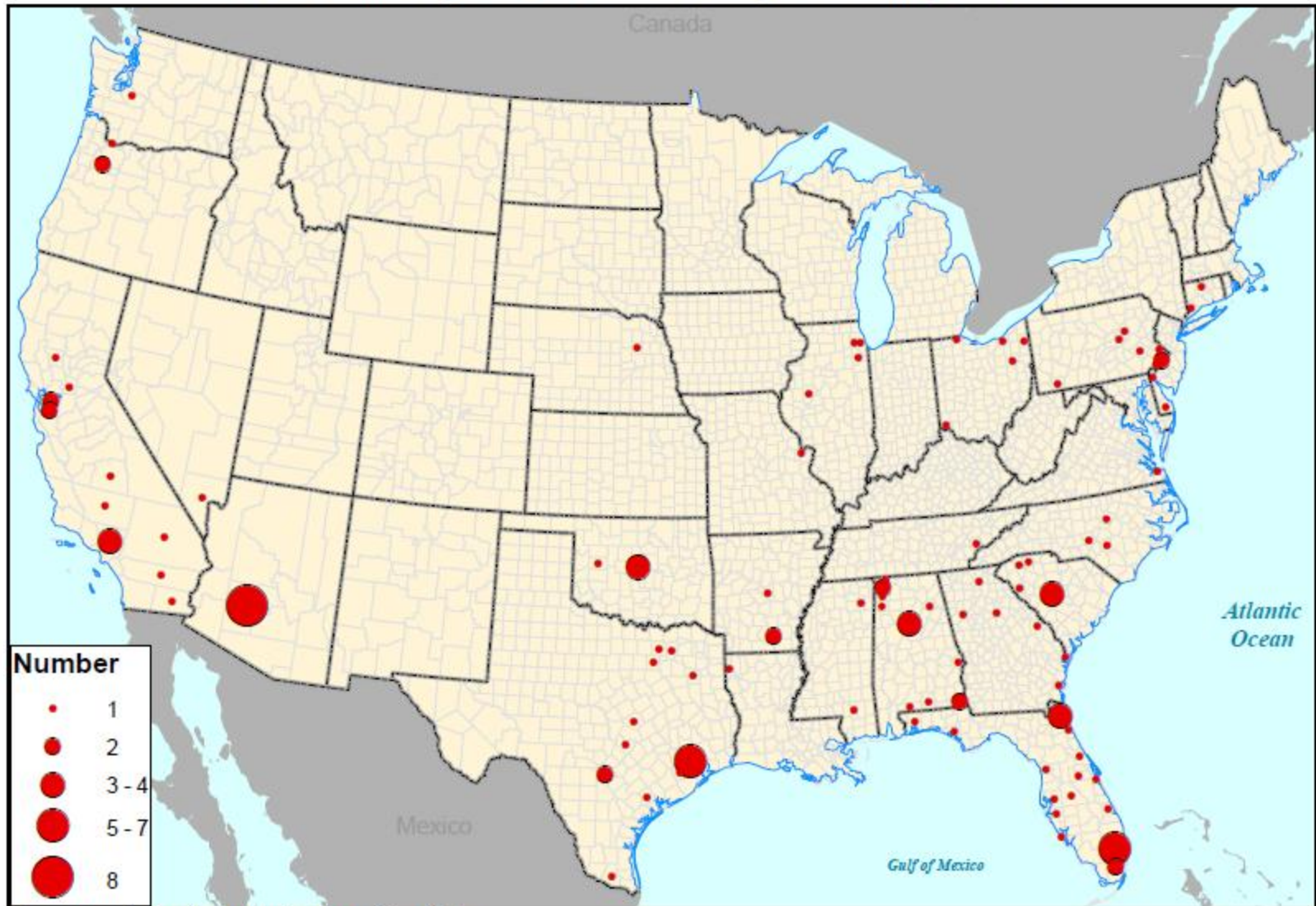

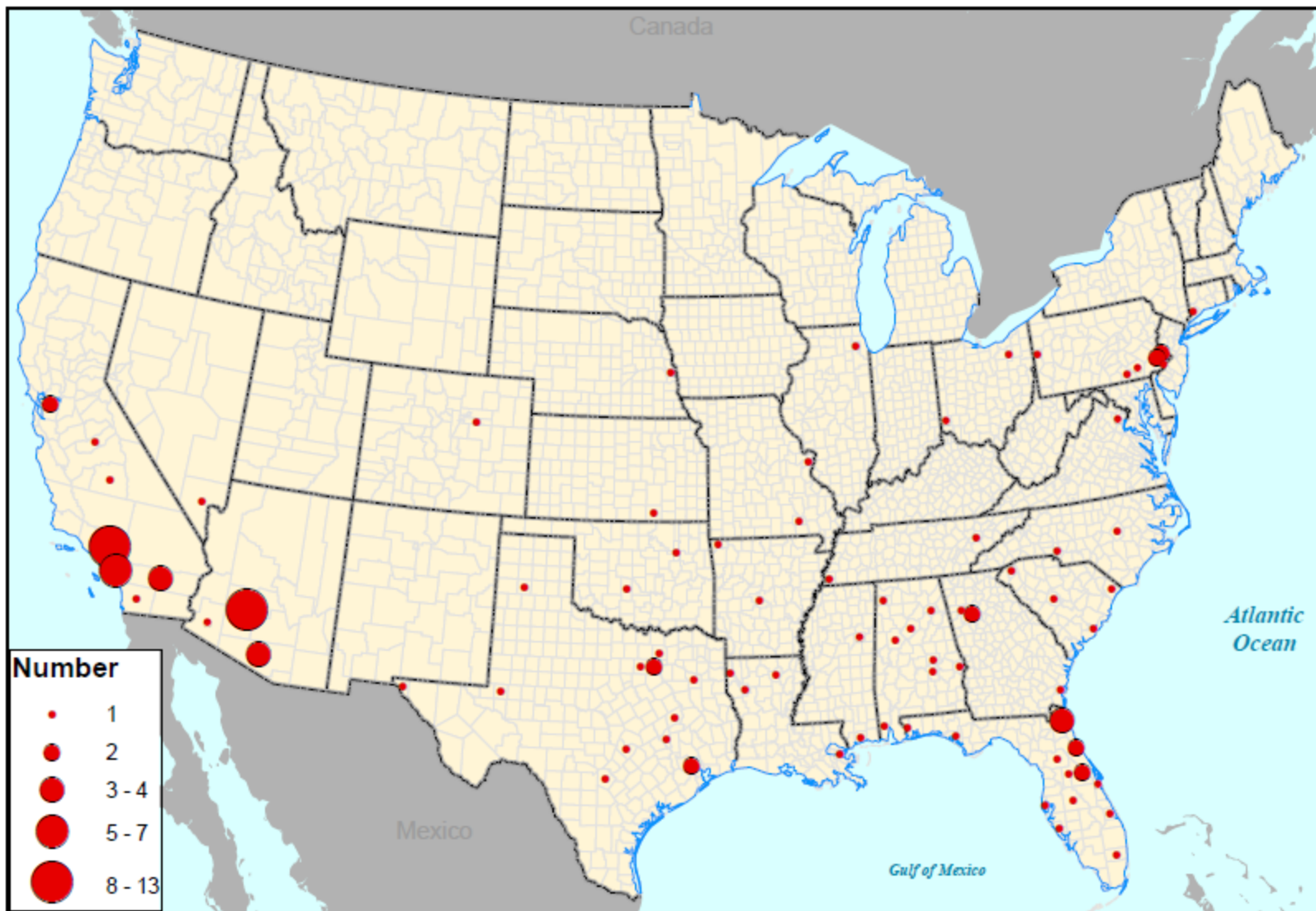

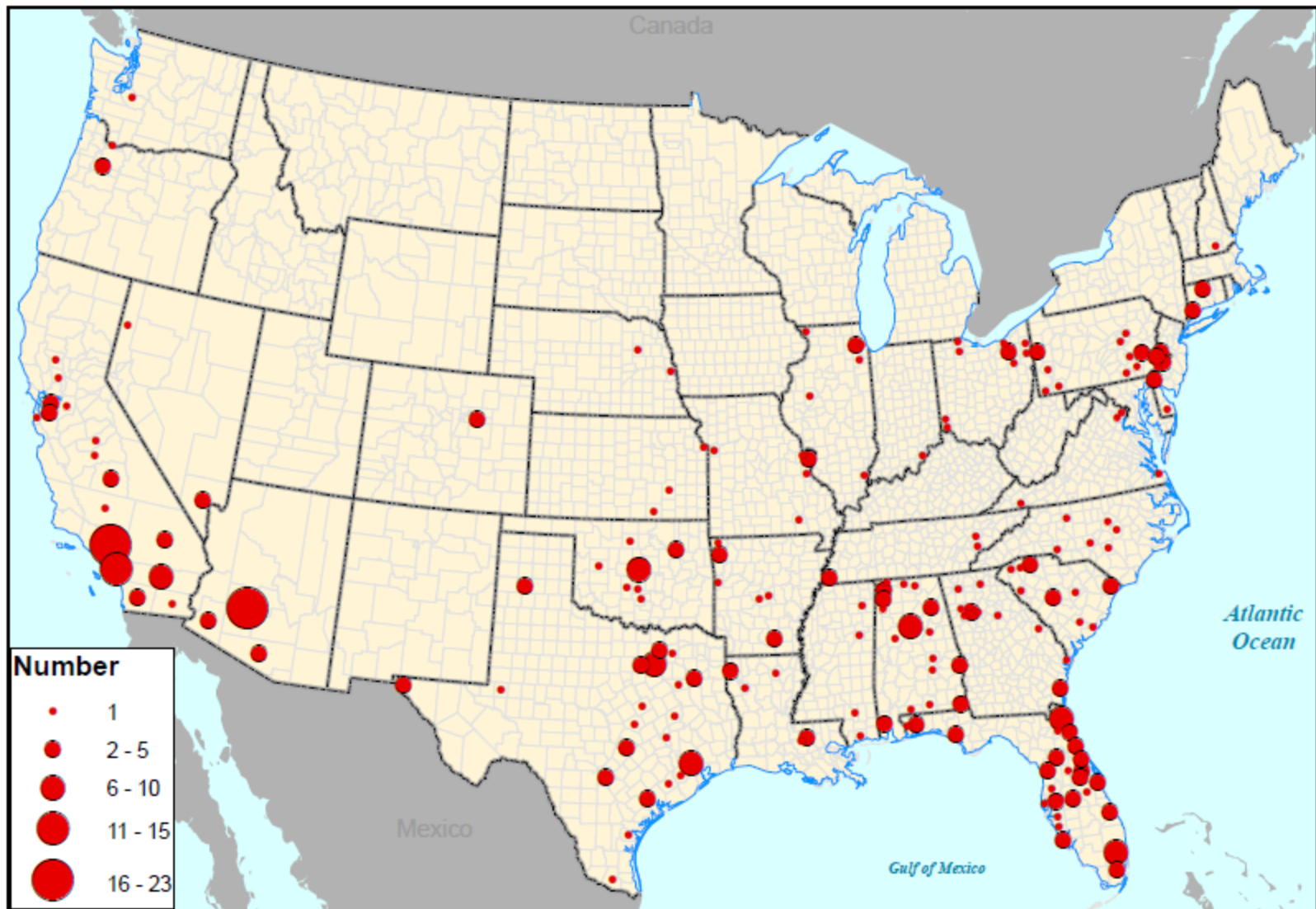

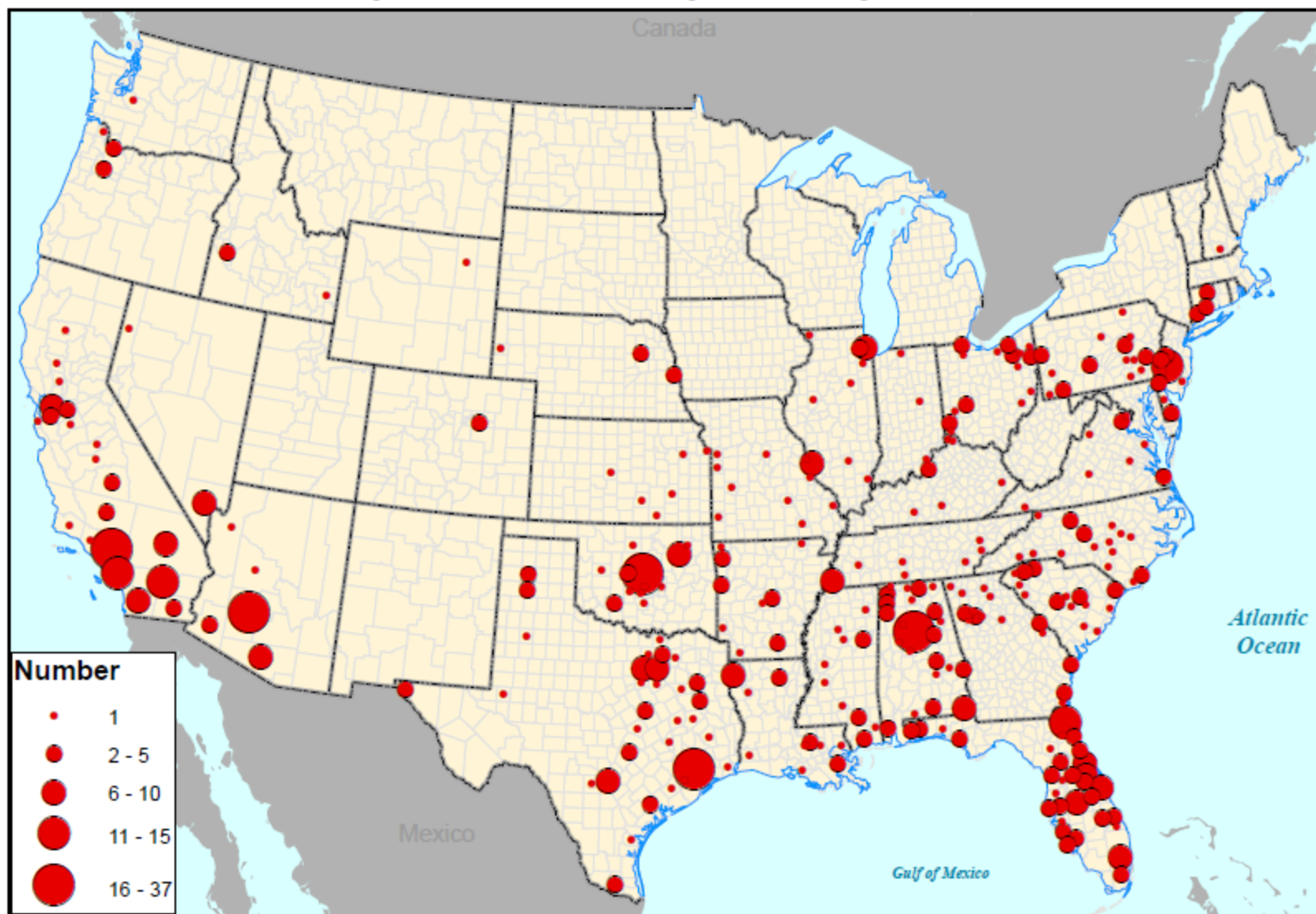

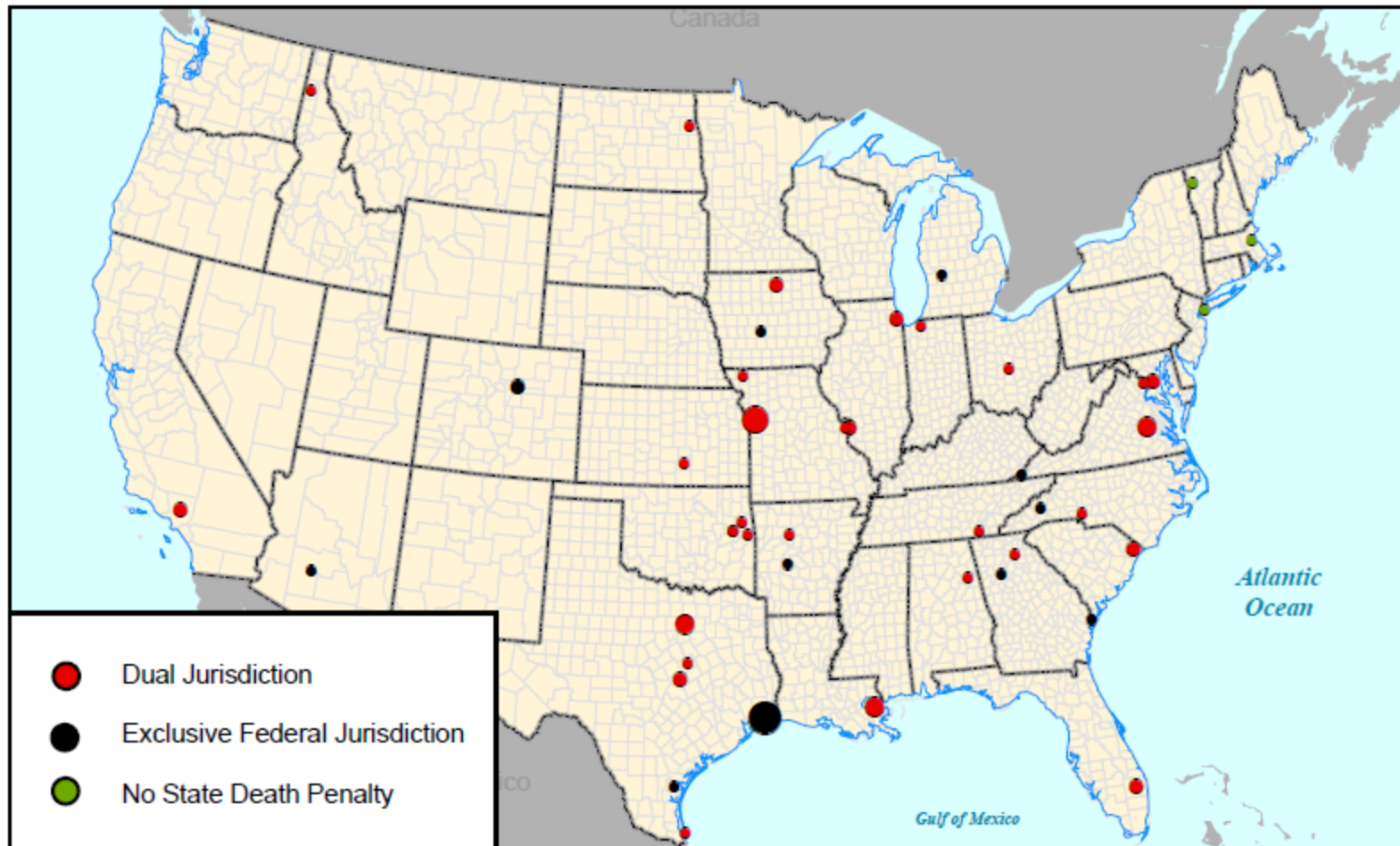

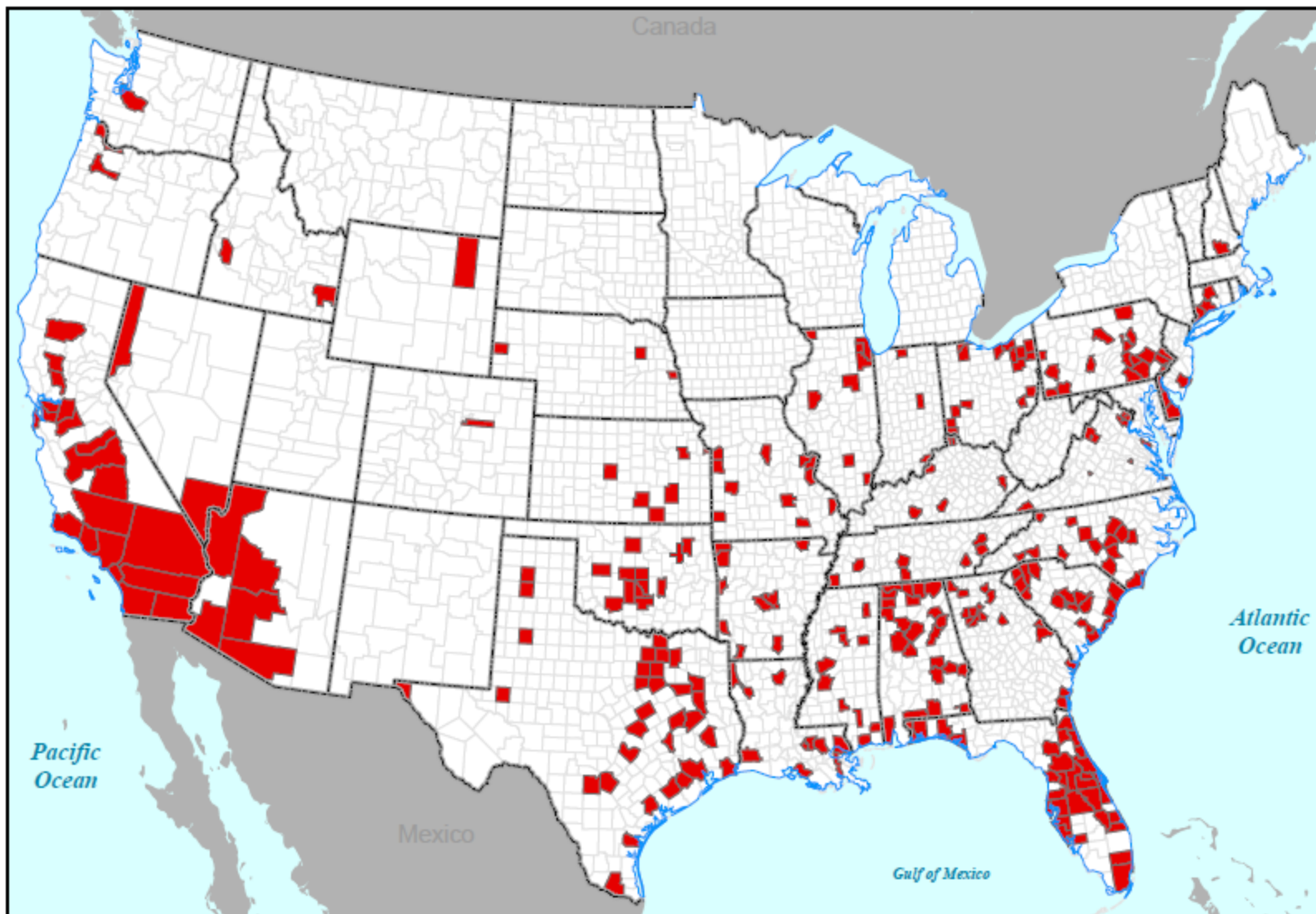


## Federal Death Sentences Since the 1988 Re-Introduction of the Federal Penalty

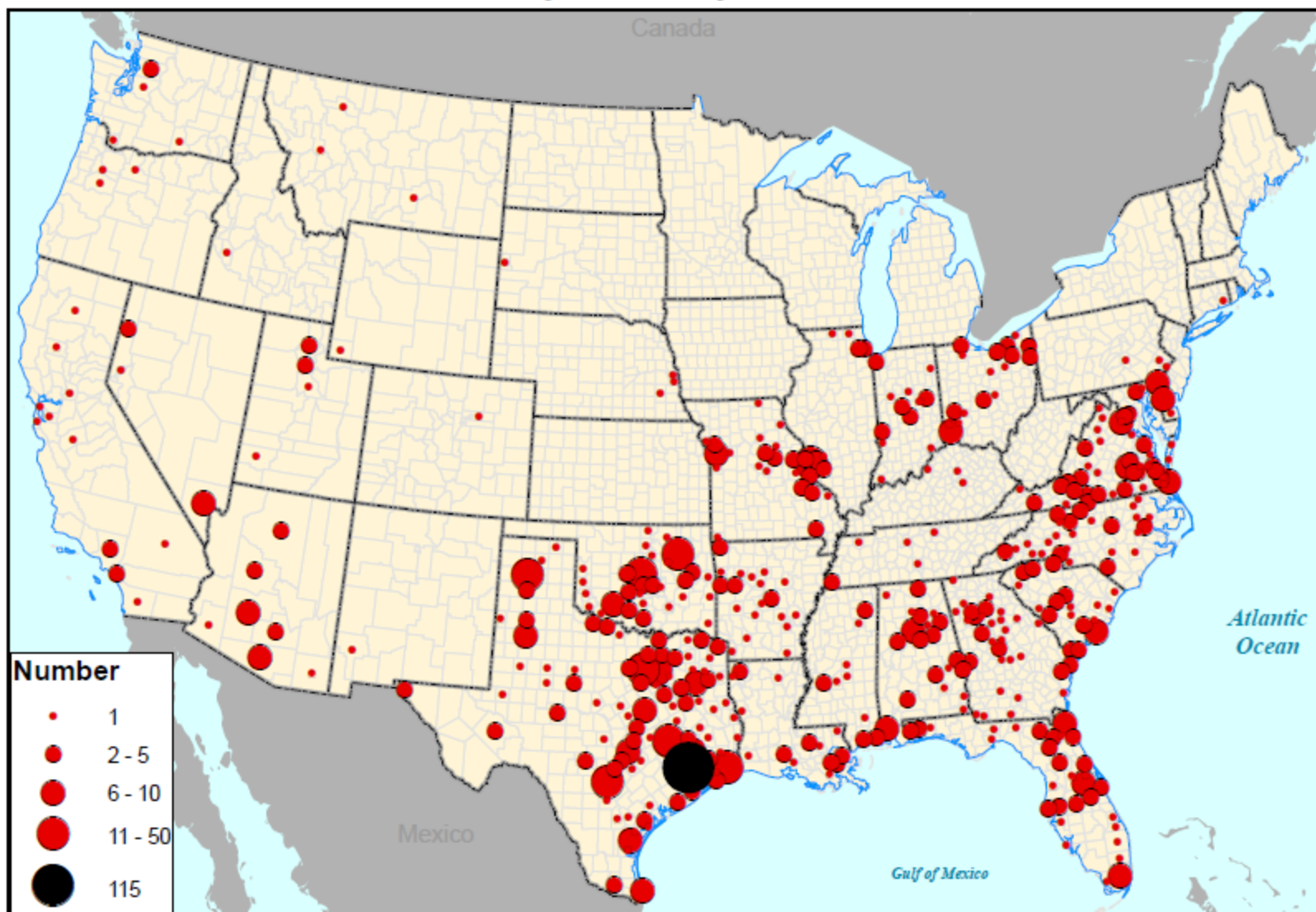

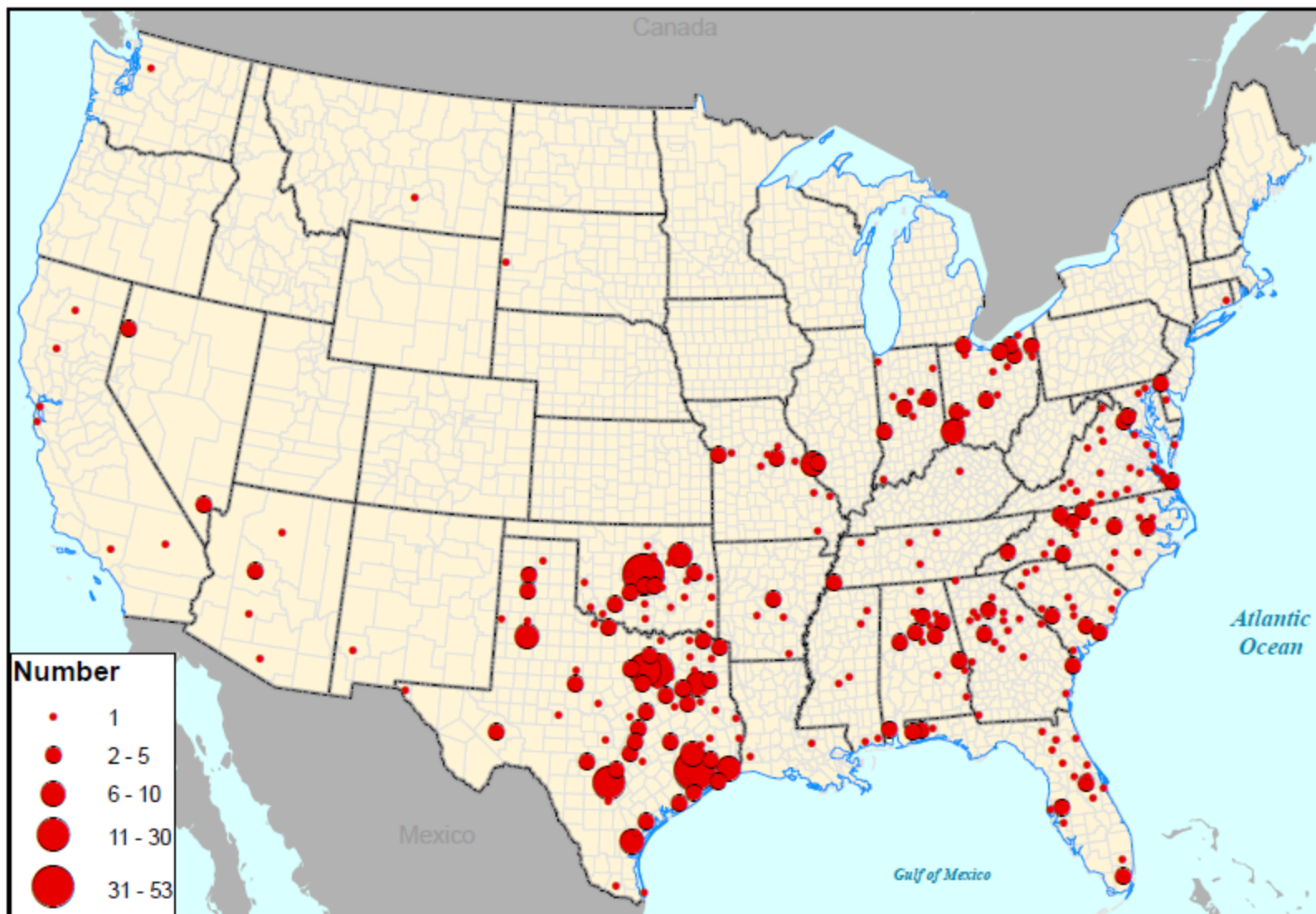
## Executions by County Since 1976

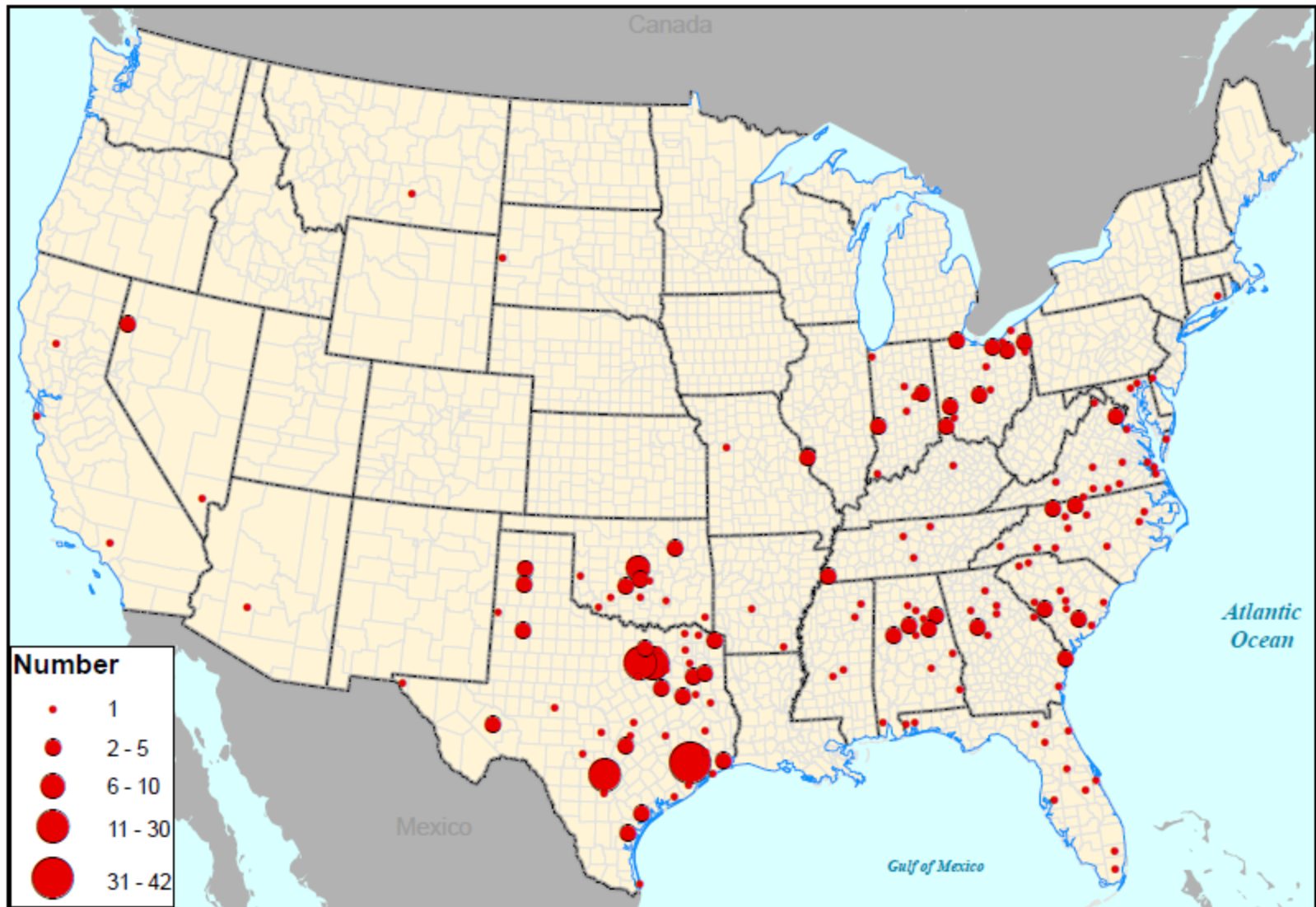


## Executions by County: 2000-2009

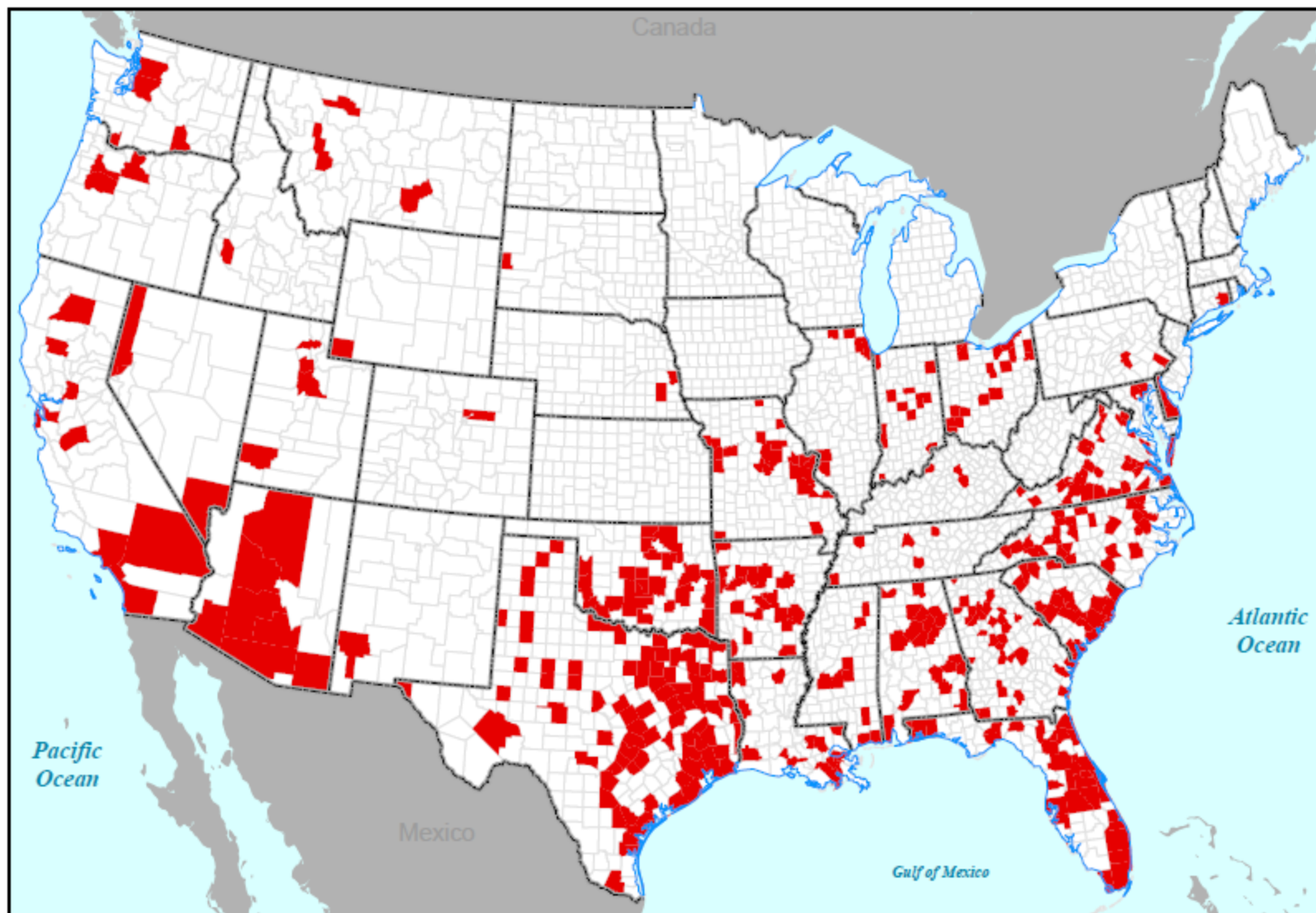

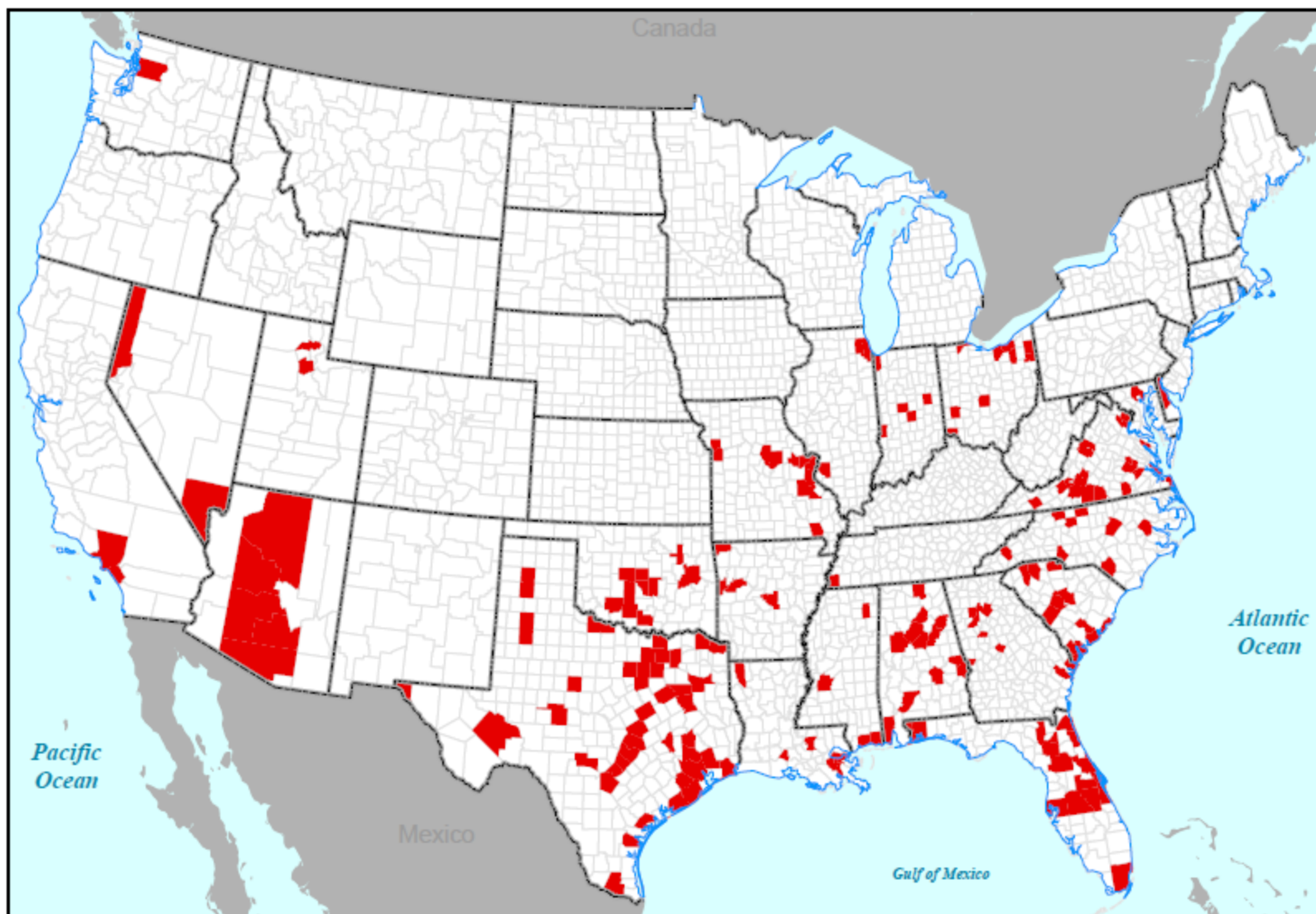

## Counties with 1 or More Execution: 1976--2009



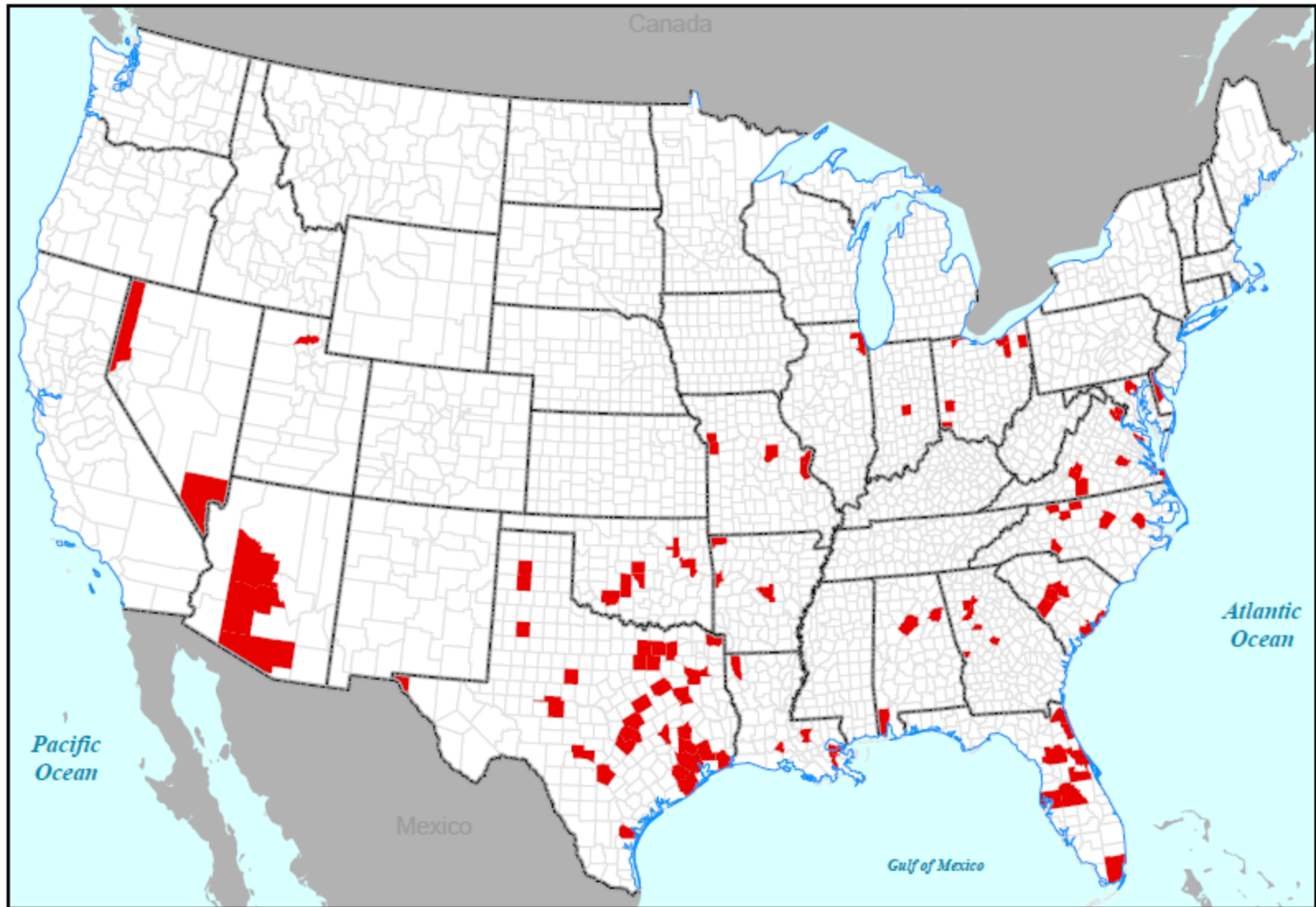

## Counties with 2 or More Executions: 1976--2009



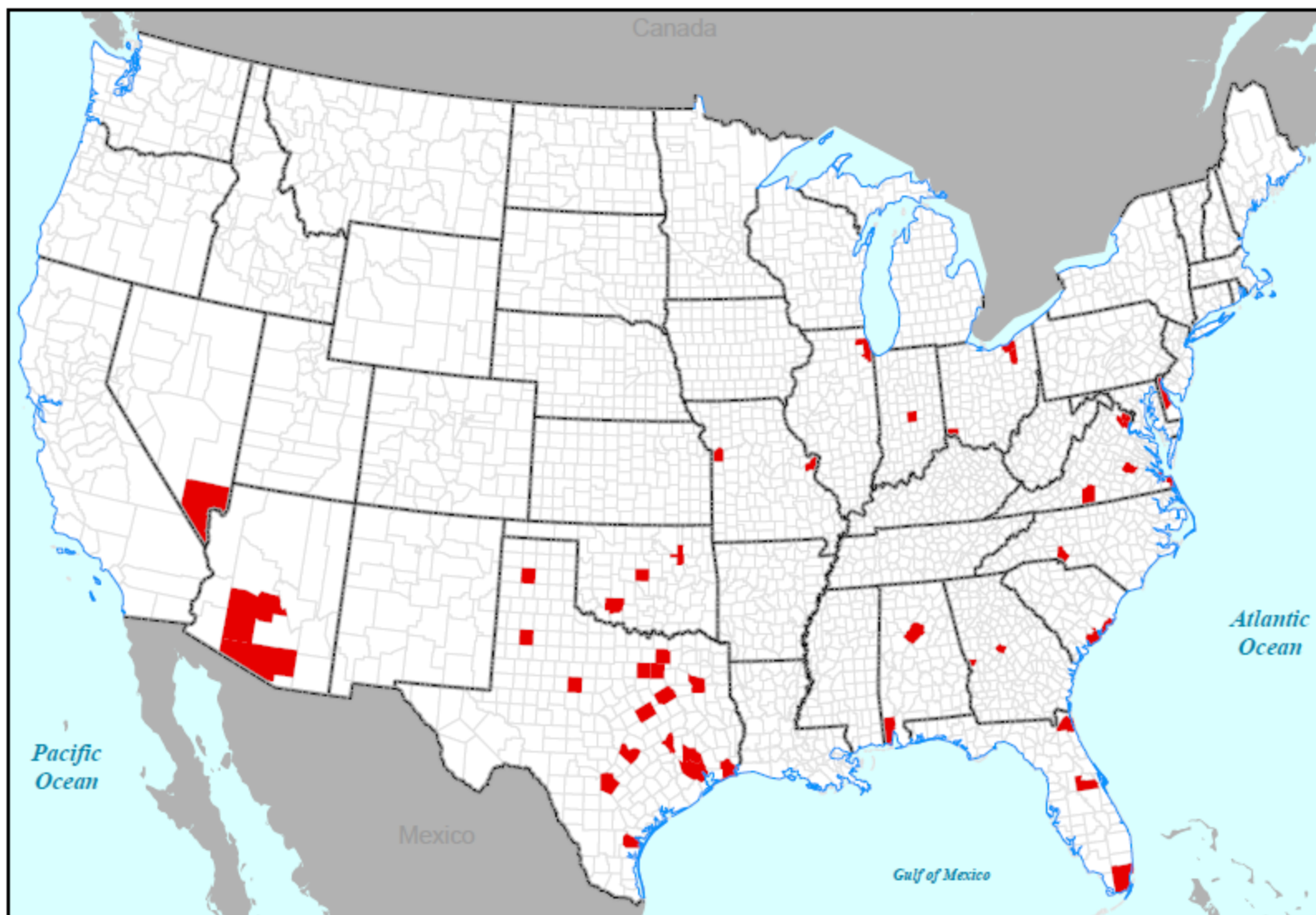

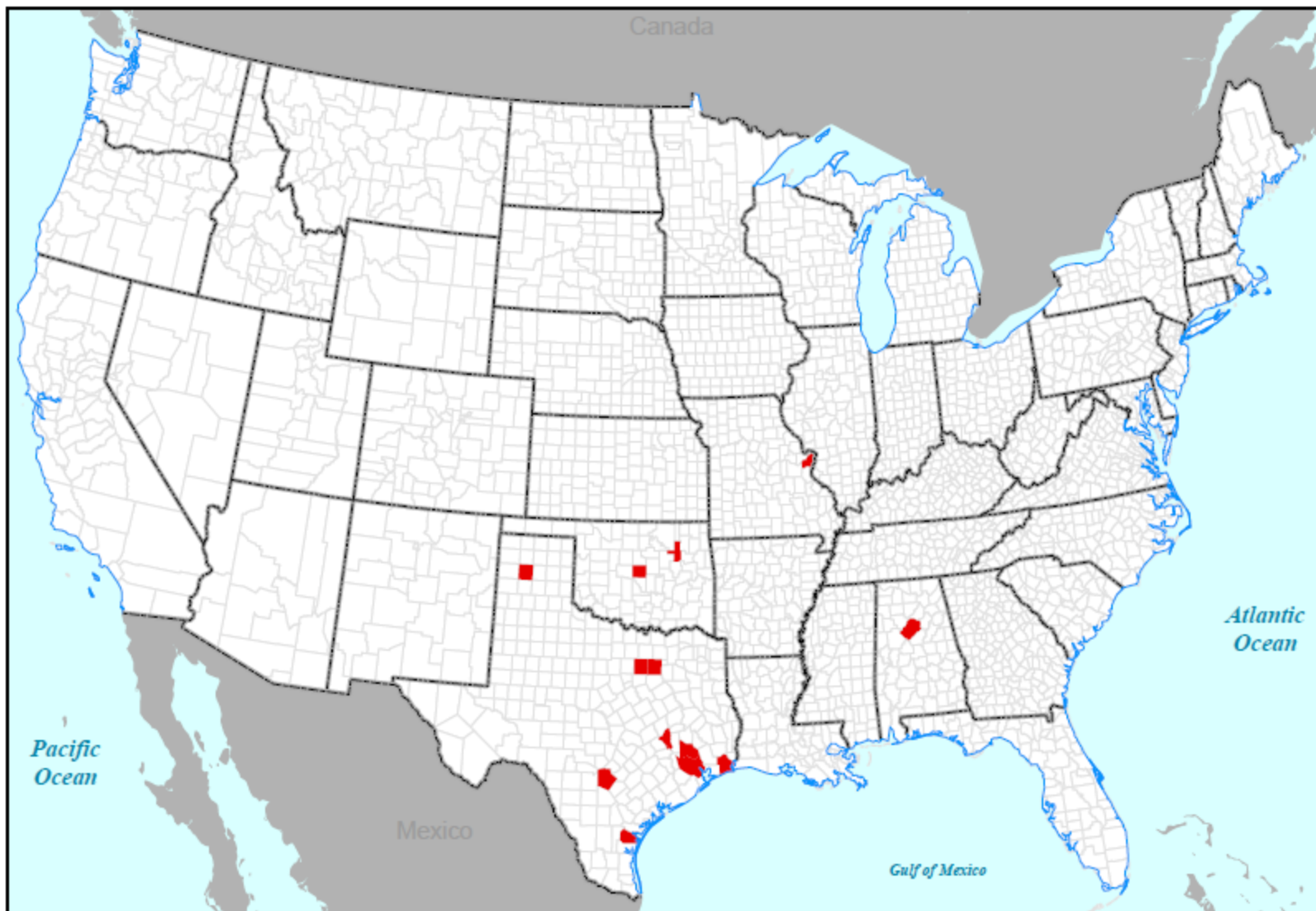
